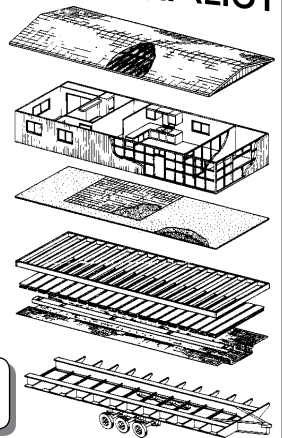

It is that time of year again. The deadline for publication of the newest Dial Directory (AKA “the yellow book”) is fast approaching. The deadline date is March 1. Over the past few years we have received complaints from residents whose numbers are not listed. Almost every time it is someone who gave us information too late for publication. Please note that if we do not have a signed permission to publish your number by the deadline date, it will take another year before you will be listed in the book.

It seems there are always new challenges handed up to keep the Book up to date for our community residents. The latest is due to the sale of Bighthouse to the big business company “Spectrum.” Since the sale, many of our northern residents are being charged to keep their service active during the months they are not here in Lincolnshire. This has caused some to just shut off the service completely. The problem being, when they return to Lincolnshire they find that when they start up again, they are issued a new phone number. The result is the number in the book is not valid. Please consider this when you head north. If you are not going to pay them to keep your phone number, don't expect it to be correct when you return. One suggestion some are doing is to give your cell phone number for the listing. Remember the dial directory is for Park Residents use only.

New owners: If you are not listed in the directory, please note that an input sheet was provided by the office along with your copy of the park rules. Please look to see if you have this form – fill it out – and return it either to the office or to Donna at lot 938 so we can input your information for next year's edition of the directory. Any corrections can also be submitted to Donna at 509-1182.

Remember, the Dial directory is only published once each year, and the next one will not be published until summer of 2018, so if you are not listed – it will be a while before your listing

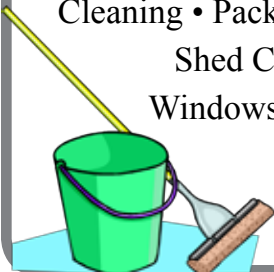

Mobile Home Owners have Rights and Responsibilities Under Florida Law.

Florida Statute Chapter 723.023 provides for the Mobile Home Owner's General Obligations. It exists under Title XL and covers "REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY MOBILE HOME TENANCIES". It reads as follows:

A mobile home owner shall at all times:

(1) Comply with all obligations imposed on mobile home owners by applicable provisions of building, housing, and health codes, including compliance with all building permits and construction requirements for construction on the mobile home and lot. The home owner is responsible for all fines imposed by the local government for noncompliance with any local codes.

(2) Keep the mobile home lot which he or she occupies clean, neat, and sanitary, and maintained in compliance with all local codes.

(3) Comply with properly promulgated park rules and regulations and require other persons on the premises with his or her consent to comply with such rules and to conduct themselves, and other persons on the premises with his or her consent, in a manner that does not unreasonably disturb other residents of the park or constitute a breach of the peace.

“Properly Promulgated Park Rules” means those “Rules” that have been submitted to the State of Florida and have been approved, by the state. Any other “Rule” is known as a “Defacto” Rule and is **NOT** enforceable as a matter of law.

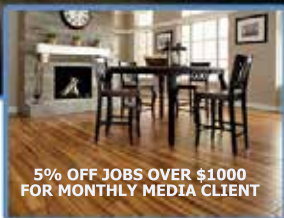

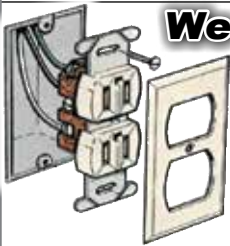

This month is an important topic: What is the difference between Service Dogs and Therapy Dogs? The Americans with Disabilities Act defines service dogs as any guide dog, signal dog or other animal who is trained to provide assistance to an individual with a disability. For example, some dogs are trained to alert to the sounds of telephones, door bells, alarm clocks and even a baby's cry. Service dogs are not considered pets. Service dogs stay with their person and have special access privileges in public places such as planes, restaurants, etc. Therapy Dogs do Not have the same special access as service dogs unless allowed by that company or establishment. Service Dogs usually wear a special vest to show they are working. Never pet or attempt to play with a Service dog when he is working. It is unethical to attempt to pass off a therapy dog as a service dog merely for purposes such as flying on a plane or being admitted to a restaurant.

Therapy Dogs are not service dogs. They are dogs who go with their owners to volunteer in settings such as schools, hospitals and nursing homes. From working with a child who is learning to read to visiting seniors in a nursing home, therapy dogs and their owners work together as a team to improve the lives of other people.

Since the 1980s, there have been significant advances in the field of animal assisted therapy and the use of therapy dogs. Organized therapy dog groups provide educational material to volunteers, they screen both the volunteers and dogs, and they provide liability insurance for when the dog and handler are volunteering in a therapy setting.

Therapy dog certification organizations are the experts in this field. It is their dedication that has organized and advanced the work of therapy dogs and their efforts should be acknowledged and appreciated. Much of this article can be found in the AKC website.

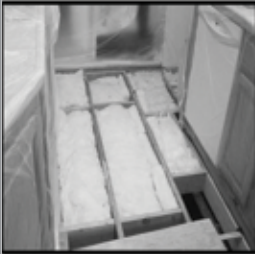

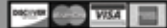

Veteran's Corner

An engineer never applied the emergency brakes before the Amtrak passenger train traveling 50 mph faster than the posted speed limit derailed Monday, killing three passengers and injuring dozens more. One of the frontline responders was a 23-year-old Army officer from Oklahoma who had just arrived last month at Joint Base Lewis-McChord. Second Lt. Robert McCoy had finishing up morning exercises and was heading home to Lacey for a quick shower in his Dodge truck when he heard a loud noise. Looking ahead of him on I-5, he saw a concrete barrier along the trestle crumble, and a rail car break through, then hang off the side. "From there, my adrenaline kind of kicked in," said McCoy, who is assigned to the 56th Multifunctional Medical Battalion. "I grabbed tourniquets I had in my truck and approached the scene." McCoy says he initially focused on wounded passengers lying underneath the dangling train car that he feared might fall and crush them. Some he carried to safety, while he supported others who had trouble walking. Then McCoy climbed on an overturned train car to reach those inside the other car suspended off the trestle. One elderly woman was hanging outside the car, and he was able to get his arms underneath her and get her down. Then he entered the car, which had luggage racks broken and baggage strewn everywhere among the wounded inside. Many of the passenger's insiders, though injured, were able to get out of the car under their own power. But not all McCoy assisted a woman with a severe break in her leg. He also tried -- unsuccessfully -- to pry open a jammed bathroom door where a father and young infant were trapped inside. Eventually they were rescued by rescue personnel who had an ax and crow bar to break down the door. McCoy said he stayed on scene for about three hours until finally getting back into his truck and heading back to this Lacey home.

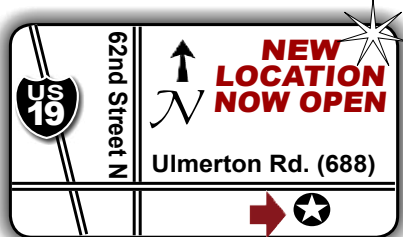

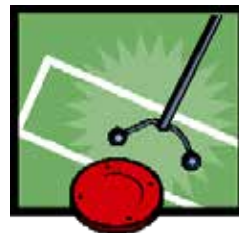
Shuffleboard

New mineral found on Martian surface

NASA has discovered evidence of an ironoxide mineral on the surface of Mars, the Sci-News website reports. The mineral, called hematite, was detected by spectral analysis of photos taken by the space agency's Curiosity rover in an area known as the Vera Rubin Ridge.

Curiosity zeroed in on a rock dubbed "Christmas Cove," and used its dust removal tool, a wire-bristled brushed, to uncover an area some 2.5 inches across.

Observations made the rover's Mast Camera (Mastcam) and its Chemistry and Camera (ChemCam) confirmed the presence of the hematite, a mineral that may provide information about ancient environmental conditions on the red planet.

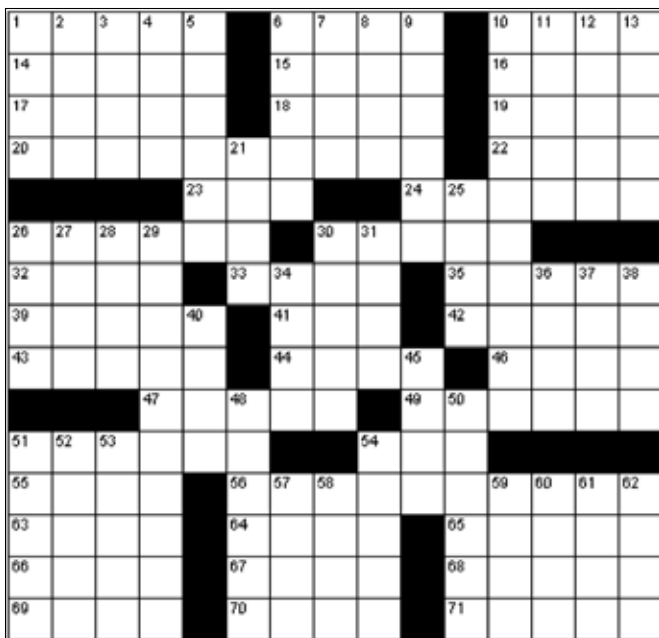

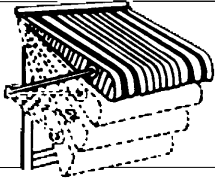
