



If you know of someone who needs to have their name added to the book, please contact them and remind them of the deadline date. In the event that you are new in the park, but do not want to have your number published, please still provide it to Donna with the note to leave it unlisted, so that the block captain will have it for emergency use.

If you did not provide us with your new numbers and **permission to publish them**, your number will not be listed in the directory. Over the past few years we have received complaints from residents whose numbers are not listed. Almost every time it is someone who gave us information too late for publication, or gave us a paper with a number not containing the required permission to publish. Please note that if we do not have a signed permission to publish your number, or an e-mail, it will take another year before you will be listed in the book.

New owners: If you are not listed in the directory, please note that an input sheet was provided by the office along with your copy of the park rules. Please look to see if you have this form – fill it out – and return it either to the office or to Donna at lot 938,

Remember, the Dial directory is only published <u>once</u> each year. <u>The directory is not produced by the office</u>. It is a resident's club function, so don't expect the office to update your information for you. If you do not wish to have your birthday or anniversary listed in the Voice, please let us know but we still need a phone number as we need to let the Block Captains notify you during emergency situations like water shut-off notices or other emergencies. any of you know of the loss of Rudy, my faithful dog of 14 years. I have included this article to assist myself and others in moving on after Grieving the loss of a beloved pet. Most of us share an intense love and bond with our animal companions, so it's natural to feel devastated by feelings of grief and sadness when a pet dies. The pain of loss can often feel overwhelming and trigger all sorts of painful and difficult emotions. While some people may not understand the depth of feeling you had for your pet, you should never feel guilty about grieving for an animal friend. Why does the loss of a pet hurt so much? Whatever the circumstances of your loss, remember that grief is personal to you, so you shouldn't be ashamed about how you feel, or believe that it's somehow not right to grieve for an animal friend. While experiencing loss is an inevitable part of owning a pet, there are healthy ways to cope with the pain, come to terms with your grief, and when the time is right, perhaps even open your heart to another animal companion.

Trying to ignore your pain or keep it from surfacing will only make it worse in the long run. For real healing, it is necessary to face your grief and actively deal with it. By expressing

your grief, you'll likely need less time to heal than if you withhold or "bottle up" your feelings. Don't let anyone tell you how to feel, and don't tell yourself how to feel either. Your grief is your own, and no one else can tell you when it's time to "move on" or "get over it." Let yourself feel whatever you feel without embarrassment or judgment. It's okay to be angry, to cry or not to cry. It's also okay to laugh, to find moments of joy, and to let go when you're ready.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

#### **Association Membership and Board of Director Meetings**

Florida Statute 723.078, provides that Homeowners' Associations are required to have two types of meetings: (1) Board of Directors meetings and (2) Membership Meetings.

"Board of Director Meetings" are defined in F.S. 723.078(2) (c) and states "Meetings of the Board of Directors and meetings of its committees at which a quorum is present shall be open to all members. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be posted in a conspicuous place upon the park property at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance, except in an emergency. Notice of any meet—ing in which assessments against members are to be made for any reason shall specifically contain a statement that assessments will be considered and the nature of such assessments.

"Membership Meetings" are defined in F.S. 723.078(2) (d) and states "Members shall meet at least once per each calendar year and the meeting shall be the annual meeting and all members of the Board shall be elected at the annual meeting unless the By-Laws provide for staggered terms"

723.078(2) (c) (4) provides Association Members the right to attend meetings of the Board of Directors and its committees and includes the right to speak at such meetings with reference to all designated agenda items. The Association's Board of Directors may adopt reasonable written rules governing the frequency, duration and manner of member statements.

ast month I went over how we as humans were designed to convert most everything we eat into sugar which is absolutely essential for every cell in our body to make energy and do the job of its design. #### **Lincolnshire Travel Club**



## Cave drawing of bull is earliest of its kind

rcheologists have discovered the oldest known drawing of an animal on the wall of a cave in Indonesia, according to the U.S. News & World Report website. It's some 40,000 years old, about five feet wide, and it depicts a bull-like creature in a red silhouette.

Along with similar drawings on cave walls in Borneo, the drawing sparks renewed debate about the role of art in ancient times. Similar cave paintings have been found in France and Spain, though they're just 33,500 to 37,000 years old.

Cave dwellers began sketching humans engaged in hunting activities and dancing some 14,000 years ago in both Europe and Asia. The findings raise the possibility that humans migrated from Africa to Europe and then Asia, bringing their artistic sensibilities with them.

## **Invasion of the space worms**

ong-term space travel poses many challenges, but one of the most daunting is the loss of muscle mass in a zero-gravity environment. On a voyage to Mars, for example, space travelers could arrive on the red planet too weak to stand. Now, reports the Popular Science website, thousands of worms headed to the International Space Station (ISS) may help solve the problem.

Scientists plan to study muscle atrophy in the worms and then treat them with a special brand of RNA designed to stop the breakdown of protein and preserve the muscles in their bodies. If all goes according to plan, this could alleviate one danger to astronauts remaining in space for long periods of time.
