hapter 723 of the Florida Statutes was created by the legislature to provide a disciplined procedure for the development of a mobile home park?

In 723.054are requirements placed on the developer/park owner which grant to the park lot renter certain rights and privileges. Specifically:

- 1. The right to assemble (peacefully).
- 2. The right to use park amenities.
- 3. The right to purchase the park (right of first refusal), subject to certain conditions.
- 4. The right to have the park owner, (your landlord) explain the material reasons for a rent increase.
- 5. The right to take certain issues to mediation.

The park owner (land lord) is not under any obligation to interact with a homeowner (lessee) or homeowners' committee on any other issues except a "Sale of the Park" when a change of use is involved, "Rent Increases" and "Pass-on or Pass through" issues.

Knowledge and understanding of the community and environment in which you live is important in being able to enjoy and understand the Lincolnshire community.

#### **Shiraoke**







#### **VETERAN'S CORNER**

#### **TAPS:**

Te at Lincolnshire are very lucky to have a celebrity living here with us. He has had several stories done on by the news media and has been on TV several times. His name is Ken Deka and he lives at #1016 and he voluntarily plays Taps every night at Sunset at Indian Rocks Beach! I have personally seen it and it is very moving! Ken moved to Lincolnshire in November 2014 about a year and a half ago and that's when he started playing at the beach.

He originally just came down here to look around for a couple of weeks. One of the first places he went was the American Legion Post 119. He said "They were some of the nicest people he ever met." One of the vice commanders (Lou Grimm) took him under his wing and helped him find a place. Lou lived here for years and knew of a place that was for sale. Lou's old neighbor had health issues and had to put the place up for sale. He liked it, bought it and is glad he did.

He was in the Army for 3 years from 1965 - 1968. He joined straight out of high school. That's when he learned to love and respect TAPS. Playing it in the Boy scouts is one thing but it took on a whole new meaning when he joined the Army.

Before his brother died he thought the military would provide burial honors. He said this was not true and if you're not a member of a military organization all you get is a grave marker. Fortunately, they were both members of the American Legion. He thinks every veteran should have TAPS played when they die. So he started playing for the guys that did not belong and would normally not have any military honors.

One day he saw a guy play TAPS at sunset. He thought it was beautiful and so did the crowd. He was surprised when everyone applauded. That's when he realized that TAPS isn't just for funerals, and it's not just for soldiers. When you hear it played at sunset on the beach you can think about anyone you want. One time a guy came up to him all in tears, shook his hand and thanked him. The guy said his dog died that day.

#### **HISTORY of TAPS:**

"Taps" concludes many <u>military funerals</u> conducted with honors at <u>Arlington National Cemetery</u> and elsewhere in the United States. The tune is also sounded at many memorial services in Arlington's Memorial Amphitheater and at grave sites throughout the <u>cemetery</u>.

Captain John C. Tidball, West Point Class of 1848, started the custom of playing "Taps" at military funerals. In early July 1862 at Harrison's Landing, a corporal of Tidball's Battery A, 2nd Artillery, died. He was, Tidball recalled later, "a most excellent man". Tidball wished to bury him with full military honors, but, for military reasons, he was refused permission to fire three guns over the grave. Tidball later wrote, "The thought suggested itself to me to sound taps

instead, which I did. The idea was taken up by others, until in a short time it was adopted by the entire army and is now looked upon as the most appropriate and touching part of a military funeral." As Tidball proudly proclaimed, "Battery A has the honor of having introduced this custom into the service, and it is worthy of historical note.

It became a standard component to U.S. military funerals in 1891

"Taps" is sounded during each of the military wreath ceremonies conducted at the <u>Tomb of the Unknown Soldier</u> every year, including the ones held on <u>Memorial Day</u>. The ceremonies are viewed by many people, including veterans, school groups, and foreign officials. "Taps" also is sounded nightly in military installations at non-deployed locations to indicate that it is "lights out". "It lets the veteran show the respect he did when he was in the service, but it also reminds him of the patriotism he was allowed to show his country," It gives you a feeling inside. It's a feeling you get like when a comrade dies and you salute while 'Taps' is being played.

#### Why we fold the flag 13 times

Have you ever noticed how the honor guard pays meticulous attention to correctly folding the American flag 13 times? Here's what each of those 13 folds mean:

The 1st fold of our flag is a symbol of life.

The 2nd fold is a symbol of our belief in eternal life.

The 3rd fold is made in honor and remembrance of the veterans departing our ranks who gave a portion of their lives for the defense of our country to attain peace throughout the world.

The 4th fold represents our weaker nature, for as American citizens trusting in God, it is to Him we turn in times of peace as well as in time of war for His divine guidance.

The 5th fold is a tribute to our country, for in the words of Stephen Decatur, "Our Country", in dealing with other countries, may she always be right; but it is still our country right or wrong.

The 6th fold is for where our hearts lie. It is with our heart that We pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, and to the republic for which it stands, one Nation under God, Indivisible, with Liberty and Justice for all.

The 7th fold is a tribute to our Armed Forces, for it is through the Armed Forces that we protect our country and our flag against all her enemies, whether they be found within or without the boundaries of our republic.

The 8th fold is a tribute to the one who entered into the valley of the shadow of death, that we might see the light of day.

The 9th fold is a tribute to womanhood, and Mothers. For it has been through their faith, their love, loyalty and devotion that the character of the men and women who have made this country great has been molded.

The 10th fold is a tribute to the father, for he, too, has given his sons and daughters for defense of our country since they were first born.

The 11th fold represents the lower portion of the seal of King David and King Solomon and glorifies in the Hebrews' eyes, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.



The 12th fold represents an emblem of eternity and glorifies, in the Christians' eyes, God the Father, the Son, and Holy Spirit.

The 13th fold, or when the flag is completely folded, the stars are uppermost reminding us of our nation's motto, "In God We Trust."

After the flag is completely folded and tucked in, it takes on the appearance of a cocked hat, reminding us of the soldiers who served under General George Washington, and the Sailors and Marines who served under Captain John Paul Jones, who were followed by their comrades and shipmates in the Armed Forces of the United States, preserving for us the rights, privileges and freedoms we enjoy today.


