Inder the affordable Care Act (ACA), all Americans including all military members (active duty, retired, selective reserve, or retired reserve) and their eligible family members must have health care coverage that meets a minimum standard called minimum essential coverage of pay a fee. Your Tricare Coverage meets the minimum essential coverage required on the ACA.

Beginning 1 January 2016, DFAS will be providing IRS form 1095-B to all retirees, annuitants, former spouses and all individuals having Tricare coverage during all or any portion of tax year 2015. The IRS form 1095 documents that you (and you family members if applicable) have the minimum essential coverage

These forms will document the information that DFAS will provide to the IRS on yourself and you authorized family members. The forms will be required to be reported with your 2015 federal tax return. DFAS will provide you with the IRS form 1095 no later than Jan. 31, 2016

#### **Lincolnshire Kennel Club**

It's time that some of the residents of Lincolnshire became aware of some of the animal ordinances of the city of Largo. Violating these ordinances can result in very heavy fines, as well as possible animal cruelty charges, and even eventual eviction from Lincolnshire properties. Please be aware, and help us to keep Lincolnshire safe for all our pets, and residents.

Sec. 14-30 Public nuisance animals. (4) Placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts cats, dogs, raccoons, coyotes or other wildlife and thereby creates a public nuisance.

Sec. 14-63 Dogs or cats at large.

No dog or cat shall run at large within the county, as defined under this article. Any person who possesses, harbors, keeps, or has control or custody of any dog or cat which is running at large shall be in violation of this article, regardless of the knowledge, intent or culpability of the owner.

Keep your cat indoors. Sec. 14-63

Domesticated family pet cats are still required to remain indoors and not be allowed outdoors to roam freely. This category of cats is required to have a current county license. It is the county code and your cat's health and safety is better protected if he or she lives indoors. Coyotes see cats as part of their food chain and will not hesitate to try and catch your pet cat. In general, indoor cats live a longer and healthier life.

Now, the first violation of any kind will result in a citation and will start the clock on a two-year probation period for owners. Unlike state law, the first instance ..... will result in a \$300 fine.

A second animal-related offense of any kind will result in another ticket. The third offense brings a ticket and a Level I Irresponsible Owner designation with a \$300 fine.

From there, owners can incur fines of up to \$400 and restrictions on pet ownership for further offenses
