
CHRISTMAS IN LINCOLNSHIRE 2018

The following is important summary information on Florida law (statutes) that were created for various types of homes, i.e. condos, co-ops and rental mobile home communities. These statutes are subject to changes made by the Florida legislature. The lobbying group that supports mobile home parks is called the Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc. (FMO).

A. Chapter 723 of the Florida Statutes was created by the legislature to provide a disciplined





procedure for the development of a mobile home park and provides for the responsibilities of Park Owner and the Resident Home owners.

- B. In Chapter 723.054 are the requirements placed on the developer/park owner which grant to the Homeowner, certain rights and privileges. Specifically:
 - 1. The right to assemble (peacefully).
 - 2. The right to use park amenities.
 - 3. The right to purchase the park (right of first refusal), subject to certain conditions.
 - 4. The right to have the park owner (your landlord) explain the material reasons for a rent increase.
 - 5. The right to take certain issues to mediation.
- C. The park owner (land lord) is not under any obligation to interact with a homeowner (lessee). The park owner has to meet with the homeowners' committee (in our case the LHOA) on issues regarding the "Sale of the Park" when a change of use is involved, "Rent Increases", "Pass-on or Pass through costs" and maintenance issues.

Florida Statutes are available online at myflorida.com.

A Nurse's Toolbox #7

ast month I went over how we as humans were designed to live successfully on Earth thousands of years ago. Just like when we buy flowers the sticker tells us how much sun is best. Our sticker said "best lived on Earth."

This month is about how we get everything from what we swallow (or should swallow) for energy. Energy is the goal for every one of our cells including fat so they can do their job, whatever it is. Nerve cells to conduct information, muscle cells to flex and contract, skin cells to mature and replace what just fell off us and the list goes on. Let's get started!

99.9% of everything we swallow turns to sugar! The better question is how fast. Almost pure sugar like candy, cookies, pies (you get the drift here) are broken down in the stomach and small intestine. Then absorbed into our blood in less than 10 minutes or even seconds. Yikes! Fruits especially grapes, oranges are just like pure sugar. Starches like pasta, white bread, potatoes take just a bit longer like 20 minutes. Whole grains in some breads and cereals take about 30 minutes (This is not Sugar Frosted Flakes!) Vegetables (greens) take up to 45 minutes to get into our blood. Oh, corn is not a vegetable, sorry. Meat (animal, fish, and poultry) are very dense food and take from 45-60 minutes to get broken down into sugar and absorbed. When we eat combination foods like a casserole each food will take its own time to be converted to sugar. The term "balanced meal" essentially means a meal that has all the food groups and in total takes almost an hour to be completely broken down in to sugar and absorbed in the blood. Hence the term "blood sugar."

Sugars are absorbed starting in our stomach and all the way down our small intestine. We start preparing the food for conversion in to sugar in our mouths by chewing and saliva production. Did you know that we start making saliva when we even think of food? Chewing our food is a big deal! Keeping our teeth or always using dentures is key to better digestion.

Our stomach further treats our food and the small intestine completes the job of breaking almost all we eat into sugar. Sugar from our food races (I mean races) through the lining of our gut into many small blood vessels. The sugar attaches to red blood cells and floats freely in the blood circulating to every and I mean every cell in our body. Every single one! Our cells are waiting for fresh sugar. I will talk about what happens when our cells don't get "fresh sugar" every 3-4 hours next month.

So how does the sugar get from the blood into the cell to make energy? Insulin (a hormone and another big deal!) Insulin propels the sugar into each living cell 24/7/365 days. More on insulin next month.

- 1. TRICARE Open Season Runs Nov. 12 to Dec. 10. TRICARE Open Season is for enrollment in a <u>TRICARE Prime</u> or <u>TRICARE Select</u> health plan. <u>Federal Benefits Open Season</u> is for vision coverage or retiree dental coverage through the <u>Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program</u> (FEDVIP). If you are enrolled in a TRICARE health plan and do not want to make any changes, you do not have to do anything. If you have the <u>TRICARE Retiree Dental Program</u>(TRDP), provided by Delta Dental, and want dental coverage in 2019, you will need to choose a FEDVIP dental plan.
- 2. The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has revamped its <u>website</u>, which is accessed by 10 million customers per month. The new website contains homepage content that focuses on the top 20 tasks that 80 percent of VA's customer's need, the ability to login to receive a personalized experience and easy to understand plain language content. Logged in customers will find a dashboard summarizing the current status of services they receive from VA, whether they be prescription refills or claims. Customers can also update their contact information in one location rather than visiting multiple VA websites or making multiple calls.


