





VETERAN'S CORNER

- 1. As I mention at coffee hour The Honor Flight is a free trip for veterans to tour the monuments in Washington, DC. Please note that the order of priority for Veterans is Hospice Care, World War II, Korean War and Vietnam. The fall flights are scheduled for June 6 and October 24 so please apply now! As I said, I can provide any Applications that are needed. Email me at robert.behm23@gmail.com or call me at the number in the yellow phone book.
- 2. Some doctors were startled to discover the new "payment arrangement" for those willing to accept TRICARE patients. Currently most doctors receive 10 percent less than Medicare pays for their TRICARE beneficiaries. The new contract, to take effect Jan. 1, will ask them accept another 20 percent cut. Some fear this could result in fewer doctors and therapists willing to participate in TRICARE.
- 3. Starting on June 28, 2017, TRICARE will no longer include the drug Nexium in the preferred, or formulary, drug list, and it will no longer be available in military hospitals and clinics. Patients are currently being asked to switch to one of the following three preferred alternatives: (1) Omeprazole, (2) Pantoprazole, or (3) Rabeprazole. If your doctor determines that Nexium is medically necessary for you, TRICARE will continue to cover the cost of Nexium, minus the \$20 copay for a 90-day supply of home delivery and \$24 copay for a 30-day supply via a retail outlet. Your doctor must submit a prior authorization. For more information on TRICARE's formulary list, visit the TRICARE Pharmacy webpage.
- 4. The American Legion Family has called upon Congress to designate May 26, 2017, as National Poppy Day to expand awareness and provide support everywhere for all who have served and sacrificed in the U.S. Armed forces. The American Legion Auxiliary has been conducting a Poppy Program for many years and their members' raise over \$6 million annually to provide support for veterans, military service members and their families. A new webpage on the American Legion website provides multiple ways people can expand awareness locally and regionally. Also through the website, National Poppy Day donors can make safe, secure contributions that directly support military veterans and families through American Legion programs.

ID YOU KNOW?

The Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc., (FMO) is a statewide, consumer advocacy association dedicated to protecting the rights and interests and enriching the lifestyles of manufactured home owners.

Formed in 1962, the FMO has a current membership of approximately 20,000 manufactured home owners. FMO operates with more than 1,000 volunteer officers from around the state who serve members by answering questions, assisting with problems, organizing district meetings and workshops, and linking them to the Board of Directors and the administrative staff at the Largo business office.



In 1962, the St. Petersburg City Council planned to enact an ordinance mandating that mobile home owners install tie-downs, a very expensive proposition then. Peggy Johnstone, upset by the impending mandate, contacted fellow mobile home owners and, on March 26th, 77 communities came together to defeat the ordinance. The FMO was founded that day with a clear vision in place to protect the interests of manufactured/mobile home owners in Florida.

Today, the FMO is the only organizational lobby working for the benefit of mobile home owners in the state of Florida




