The edition that is being printed is already out of date and partially incomplete because residents have not shared new information in a timely manner. We will now also allow entrees via e-mail sent to the above address. E-mails will be copied & filed as permission for the listing to be published. If you choose the e-mail method, please include birthdays, anniversaries, and home state or province so you can be recognized in the voice publication. Please note, we cannot accept little scribbled papers with your number as permission to publish your new number. It must be either on the form with signature, or in the form of an e-mail. Also remember we cannot accept numbers for publication submitted by third parties. If you know of someone who needs to have their name added to the book, please contact them. In the event that you are new in the park, but do not want to have your number published, please still provide it to Donna with the note to leave it unlisted, so that the block captain will have it for emergency use.



If you did not provide us with your new numbers and <u>permission to publish them</u>, your number will not be listed in the directory. Over the past few years we have received complaints from residents whose numbers are not listed. Almost every time it is someone who gave us information too late for publication, or gave us a paper with a number not containing the required permission to publish. The following is a little history on associations. When individuals come together to discuss mutual concerns, no matter what the common element is, the nucleus of an association is formed. There is evidence that associations existed in Canada even earlier than they did in the United States. Samuel de Champlain is credited with founding the first association in Canada in 1604.

As our country was founded, American citizens began to expand and formalize guilds into what we identify as an association today. Citizens of the United States began exercising their first amendment freedoms of speech, assembly and the press. New laws were developed to support and define these new groups.

The number of community associations in the U.S. is hundreds of thousands (Florida has over 47,000). Florida has over 5,000 mobile home parks and 50 of those are in Pinellas County.



As a result of that long history, we can have confidence they will continue to form and exist in today's society. Almost every facet of life is represented in some form or fashion by an association. The challenges they face have never been greater and the new opportunities they have are just as great.

Ever wonder why associations exist, what purposes they serve and why people join them? A sense of community is at the heart of associations. People voluntarily join associations because they want to work together on a common cause or interest. Associations empower people to get involved in issues that affect their personal and professional communities and their quality of life.

Homeowner Associations (HOA) started in the mid-19th century in the United States. During this period of time, the United States was transforming from an agricultural society into an industrial society.

The number of associations was limited until the 1960's. The federal government was a major player in the expansion of HOA's. The Federal Housing Authority and the Urban Land Institute pushed for large residential developments. There was an increasing preference for architectural uniformity, available land was decreasing, construction costs were increasing and federal mortgage insurance rules were modified to include homeowner associations.

In the United States most HOA's are incorporated, and are subject to state statutes that govern homeowner associations. State oversight of homeowner associations ranges from very strict to minimal, and varies from state to state. Florida have a large body of homeowner association law and a variety of statutes to cover the various forms that exist. Your LHOA is a member of an association that supports residents of mobile home parks the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida.)

A Nurse's Toolbox #12

he 2018 hurricane season was kinder to us than September 2017 in Lincolnshire. Not so in the panhandle of Florida where Michael struck. So many stories of people leaving their homes, mobile or not, immediately to safer ground. So many without their medications, medical equipment, medical records and oxygen needs. It took on average 5-6 days before enough emergency medical teams and supplies got there.

The Atlantic hurricane season usually runs from June 1st through November 30th. Whether you believe in climate change or not the "usually" may not always prevail. For year-rounders like myself this is our storm season. Seasonal residents also have their own storm season whether tornadoes, strong rain, flooding and snow storms including remnants of our Florida hurricanes (we like to share.) Horrific weather can find us and often does. The bottom line is be prepared wherever we live.

Without being specific to any chronic condition let's say that <u>you must have</u> certain medications, oxygen, nursing services, dialysis, just had major surgery, batteries for equipment vital to your survival that require replenishment <u>within 10 days</u>. Why 10 days? In a major weather event or disaster the supply of what you absolutely need to live isn't around the corner anymore plus the supply lines to vendors, pharmacies, hospitals, clinics, home health can be threatened. We live in a new supply world where large expensive reserves of almost everything are no longer kept close. Dependence on UPS and FedEx is pervasive. Ever need a part for something and it takes 2 weeks to get it? It is the same with medical supplies. Inventories are expensive to maintain. We are somewhat fortunate in we live in a location where supplies most seniors need are more plentiful but not endless.

As an RN in Florida's Disaster response team, we start when to actually prepare. **TODAY!** Preparing isn't as hard as we think. Take it one step at a time. Starting now means you won't rush and forget something vital.

The first is life sustaining equipment. Oxygen and the equipment required to deliver is #1. Find an invoice from the vendor who brings the oxygen and maintains the devices. Put the invoice in an envelope that you will fill with other information. Take a picture with your phone too. If you have a second portable unit always ensure the other one is always full and ready to use. If you have large oxygen canisters they will be hard to transport. Oxygen concentrators can be heavy though newer versions are much lighter. You can't expect every shelter will have unlimited oxygen available. Always register early with the shelters. Also shelters may not have consistent electricity to power equipment. If your equipment has rechargeable batteries then keep them charged. Pinellas County Disaster management can help you know where the best shelter for you! Staying at home may not be an option and can be deadly. Also extremely unfair to first responders!!!

The second pretty obvious thing is medications. If you don't have a current list of your



medications then you can write down your own or better have you pharmacy print yours list. Medication organizers are a must to have. Also reminds me what day it is! However the downside is that someone else has no idea what each pill is. Believe me. So, keep your back up supply of medications in their original container from the pharmacy. Have at least one pill etc. in the prescription container from the pharmacy. Do not ever wait until the last minute to have your medications including syringes refilled. Remember, shelters don't have pharmacies and getting some vital medications in a disaster can be very difficult if not impossible. Get a plastic container with a locking lid to store all of your medications. Put your full name on the container.

Some liquid medications require refrigeration. <u>Often</u> they come in a Styrofoam container. Keep one, always! Don't toss the frozen ice bag either. Store it in your freezer. Always assume the shelter doesn't have refrigeration or the ability to keep it cool. Oh, and, write your name on the cooler! I once had someone say that their insulin is in the white one. There were 20 white ones.

Lastly, when bad weather is coming don't jump around to all the TV channels for weather news. Stick with your favorite. Anxiety can get out of hand when there is too much seemingly differing information. Get ready and start today.

lying Space A – Did you know if you are a Military Retiree with 20 years that you and your dependent can fly Space A and you would fall into a (Category VI). MacDill for example has 15 seats to England every 3 weeks. You must be flexible since you are a CAT VI. In 2019 service connected 100



percent disabled veterans were <u>also added to Category VI</u>, although they are not permitted to fly with dependents. You must know where you want to go. Flights are tentatively announced 72 hours ahead of time, even for regularly scheduled flights. Download the Take-a-Hop app on your smartphone (\$6.99), which lists all AMC terminals and their con-tact information. Then, start calling the information lines of any terminals you plan to fly out of. Interested in Asia? Look into the Patriot Express, a regular shuttle from the West Coast. Europe more your style? Check flight times on the Rotator from the East Coast. Or skip the jet lag and try to hop a flight to Key West! **Do you have all your paperwork?** You must have your military ID card. You must have a passport if you are traveling overseas. Again, flexibility is the Key.

implied Wednesday during a hearing on the future of draft registration in the U.S. Asked whether requiring women to register for a potential draft would "result in a more lethal military," Assistant Secretary of Defense for Manpower and Reserve Affairs James Stewart avoided answering the question directly, instead pointing out that all military occupations are now open to men and women and the military basically looks "for standards." "As long as those individuals meet standards, we are open to them," Stewart said. But when Jeanette James, a member of a federal commission studying the future of the draft and a former professional House Armed Services Committee staff member, pressed Stewart, pointedly asking, "So am I hearing, 'Yes, it would lead to increased lethality in the military?" Stewart replied without hesitation: "It is, already." Until now, the Defense Department has stayed silent on the proceedings of the National Commission on Military, National and Public Service, which is conducting a three-year review of public service in America, considering whether the U.S. needs the Selective Service System and if women should be required to register. "The full and equal participation of women throughout the military, including the selective service system, should be recognized as an imperative," The ongoing implementation of a ban excluding, even discharging, transgender service members not only is wrong, it wrongly deprives the U.S. military of their talent and dedication to service."





Early birds versus night owls—who's better off?

The early bird gets the worm, and early risers enjoy other benefits, according to a story on the *New York Post* website. A survey of sleep habits involving 2,000 people found that, among other things, self-identified early birds have more sex on a weekly basis than their night owl counterparts.

The survey also found that early birds generally make more money, are more likely to work in an office setting, and describe themselves as happy. They're also more likely to be married with children in their home. On the other hand, night owls are typically shy and sarcastic, likely to believe in ghosts and cryptids, and more often single.

They tend to sleep about the same amount—seven hours a night for early birds and six hours for night owls. However, early birds are light sleepers, and they feel more well-rested when they get up than night owls.

Disconnecting may not lead to the benefits you're looking for

ver feel the need to disconnect from your devices for a "digital detox"? The Yahoo Finance website reported on a survey by Mojo Vision (Saratoga, California), which found that people tend to use technology as much, if not more, after distancing themselves from their smartphones and tablets for a while.

The survey of 1,000 Americans found that 67 percent agree that technology makes life easier, but 55 percent believe that all that tech is a distraction, with one-third worrying that it hurts people's ability to connect with one another. Still, 54 percent said that abstaining from their devices didn't produce the positive benefits they'd hoped for—or at least were unsure whether it had a beneficial impact.

The most common strategies for "subtracting" tech are setting devices to send fewer notifications, putting them on a "Do Not Disturb" setting, scheduling times to not use their devices, or simply turning them off for a period of time.

Though he knew his wife of 30 years would no longer be able to see the beautiful fuchsia-colored petals, he hoped the sweet fragrance of the flowers would lure her outdoors and out of her deepening depression. It didn't, for a while, and then something pretty wonderful happened.

As the farmer continued to plant more flowers, they thrived and spread across the farmland. People from surrounding areas, even tourists, began to visit the farm. Everyone wanted to see the beautiful pink fields and walk among the spring flowers. With so many new and different people showing up on their land, the farmer's wife began to wander outside and interact with the visitors. She was happy again.

For the past 25 years, the shibazakura fields that surround the home of Toshiyuki and Yasuko Kuroki have sparked joy and wonder in the hearts of many. The Kurokis receive about 7,000 visitors a year at the farm during March and April, and they no longer raise dairy cows.

Their story is a reminder that love and flowers are a powerful healing force.
