It might seem strange to be talking about fleas at what seems to be a very early time in the season, but just a reminder to everyone that this is Florida, and the bugs do not take a "Warm winter's Nap," They are alive and well all year & are just waiting for a chance to jump up on us with a sneak attack as we walk through the dewy grass in the morning. With the number of pets walking through the park at this time of the year, many unprotected pets, and those less cared for (unfortunately) will be spreading those fleas to others all season. I recommend that you tell your humans about some of the great flea protections that are out there. My particular favorite is "Trifexus." It's a simple once a month pill that kills fleas, prevents them from wanting to attach in the first place, protects against mosquitos and tics, and prevents Heart Worm as well. You can send your Human to the Vet to get it, but if not, just be sure you have some protection. As weather gets warmer, there will be even more bugs out there too.
