





his month I would like to talk about Flag Etiquette Do's and Don'ts. When displaying the flag do the following:

- Display the flag from Sunrise to sunset on flagstaffs. If you want to fly the flag for 24hrs it must be properly illuminated during darkness.
- When placed on a staff the U.S, Flag must be placed above all other flags.
- When displayed with other flags the U.S. Flag goes to the observers left.
- When placed on a podium the flag should be placed on the speakers' right.
- Replace all Torn or Tattered Flags by disposing of them with the VFW, American Legion, or the Boy Scouts.

Do not's of Flag Etiquette:

- Don't let the flag touch the ground.
- Don't use the flag as clothing.
- Don't fly the flag upside down unless there is an emergency.
- Don't use the flag as a cover.
- Don't draw on the flag or use it as a decoration.

U.S NAVY AND COAST GUARD SHIPS IN VIETNAM - The VA maintains a list of U.S. Navy and Coast Guard Ships associated with Military Service in Vietnam and possible exposure to Agent Orange. This evolving list helps Veterans who served aboard ships, including Blue Water Veterans find out if they may qualify for presumption of herbal exposure. Veterans must meet the VA's criteria for service in Vietnam, which includes aboard boats on the inland waterways or brief visits ashore, to be presumed to have been exposed to herbicides. Veterans who qualify for presumption of herbicide exposure are not required to show they were exposed to Agent Orange or other herbicides when seeking VA compensation for disease related to Agent Orange exposure. Ships or boats that were part of the Mobile Riverine Force, Inshore Fire Support (ISF) Division 93 or any other group that operated on the inland waterways of Vietnam and who's Military records confirm they were aboard these ships qualify for presumption of herbicide exposure.


