

Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.







3. Social Security and Veterans Affairs Partnership Means Faster Disability Decisions for Veterans

Posted on January 26, 2017. The Social Security Administration announces the launch of a new Health IT initiative with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) that enables all Social Security disability case processing sites to receive medical records electronically from all VA facilities. Veterans will receive a faster decision on their Social Security disability claim, speeding them and their dependents through this new process. Both agencies will save time and money with an automatic request through the eHealth Exchange.

4. TRICARE Expands Coverage for Treatment of Congestive Heart Failure

Congestive Heart Failure is now a covered diagnosis under the TRICARE cardiac rehabilitation benefit.

Heart failure occurs when the heart is unable to pump enough blood to meet the body's needs. This may happen when the heart muscle itself is weaker than normal or when there is a defect in the heart that prevents blood from getting out into the circulation. The American Heart Association lists several signs of heart failure:

Shortness of breath, Chronic coughing or wheezing, Build-up of fluid; Fatigue or feeling light headed, Nausea or lack of appetite, Confusion; High heart rate. If you are experiencing these symptoms, talk to your health care provider. If you have been diagnosed with heart failure, it's important for you to manage and keep track of symptoms and report any sudden changes to your healthcare team. Providers of cardiac rehabilitation services must be TRICARE-authorized hospitals or freestanding cardiac rehabilitation facilities. All cardiac rehabilitation services must be ordered by a physician.

DID YOU KNOW?

Association Membership and Board of Director Meetings

Florida Statute 723.078, provides that Homeowners' Associations are required to have two types of meetings: (1) Board of Directors meetings and (2) Membership Meetings.

"Board of Director Meetings" are defined in F.S. 723.078(2)(c) and states "Meetings of the Board of Directors and meetings of its committees at which a quorum is present shall be open to all members. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be posted in a conspicuous place upon the park property at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance, except in an emergency. Notice of any meet—ing in which assessments against members are to be made for any reason shall specifically contain a statement that assessments will be considered and the nature of such assessments.

"Membership Meetings" are defined in F.S. 723.078(2)(d) and states "Members shall meet at least once per each calendar year and the meeting shall be the annual meeting and all members of the Board shall be elected at the annual meeting unless the By-Laws provide for staggered terms"

723.078(2)(c)(4) provides Association Members the right to attend meetings of the Board of Directors and its committees and includes the right to speak at such meetings with reference to all designated agenda items. The Association's Board of Directors may adopt reasonable written rules governing the frequency, duration and manner of member statements.





Fresh or frozen? The choice is yours

om may tell you over and over again to eat fruits and vegetables that are fresh, but nutrition experts say that frozen produce isn't necessarily inferior. According to *The New York Times*, most nutrients are surprisingly hardy: Iron, for example, stands up to freezing quite well, and fiber does its job whether it's frozen or fresh.

Scientists at the University of California-Davis analyzed the vitamin content in several different varieties of fresh and frozen produce, including blueberries, broccoli, carrots, spinach, and strawberries. They found no significant differences between fresh and frozen items, and even discovered that frozen broccoli contains more riboflavin—a B vitamin—than the fresh selection. Similarly, frozen blueberries have more vitamin C than fresh.

Experts recommend looking for produce frozen using the IQF process—individually quick frozen"—for the highest quality.

Watch for these sources of illness while traveling

raveling has enough hassles—check-in lines, lost luggage, bad airline food—without adding germs to the mix. Be safe by watching out for these common sources of germs and bacteria that can make you sick when you travel (from the CNN website):

- Washroom stall locks. In one test, airport stall locks were found to have an average of 70 colony-forming units (CFUs) per square inch. Use soap and water or a good hand sanitizer after touching them.
- Seatbelt buckles. Clean your hands after buckling up. Airplane belt buckles can have up to 230 CFUs per square inch.
- Lavatory flush buttons. These can get pretty nasty, containing 265 CFUs per square inch (although overhead vents and tray tables have more).
- Drinking fountains. Thirsty? Maybe buy a bottle of water instead. The buttons on airport drinking fountains have been found to hold 1,240 CFUs per square inch.
