NUTRITION SPOT

here are many health claims cropping up on the front of food packaging. A recent article in Consumer Reports' "Food Sense" states that the "big print" rarely tells the whole story. "Multigrain" - These foods may have more than 1 grain, but those grains may be refined and the nutritious germ and bran have been removed. Look for 100% whole grain.

"No trans fats" - currently that may be used if the serving has less than 0.5 grams. But if in the ingredients column you see the words "partially hydrogenated oils," that food has trans fats, period! "No nitrates or nitrites" - these chemicals used to preserve meats such as bacon, ham, hot dogs, luncheon meats may form possible cancer-causing nitrosamines. The product that claims it doesn't contain them may also use celery juice or powder to cure them and those ingredients can naturally produce nitrates that carry the same risks. These are popular meats in the country, so try to use sparingly.

"Reduced Sodium" - to qualify for this term they need have only 25% less that the regular version. If sodium (salt) is a hazard to your health, (high blood pressure, coronary disease) look for "low sodium" foods. They usually have flavorings or spices to enhance the taste.




