

Roseate Spoonbill

hecking out the wonderful parks we have in our area, I discovered Bayhead Pond located just outside of downtown Largo. Early morning April 2014 walking with Cookie, (my dog) I spotted this beautiful pink bird flying from a tree I was walking under, took a picture and then became curious! Roseate spoonbill with its bright pink coloring leads many Florida tourists



to think they have seen a flamingo. This is a very special bird and Tampa Bay Area is one of the best regions for spotting.

One of Florida's most distinctive wading birds. They feed on fish, crustaceans (shrimp, crayfish) and aquatic insects with its unusual spatulate bill. Roseate spoonbill uses its odd bill to strain small food items out of the water.

Because of their beautiful plumage, their feathers were in great demand for feather boas, fans and hats. Fortunately, laws were passed outlawing the collection of the feathers to assure the survival of the birds. They have also suffered with the drainage and pollution of their wetland habitat.

Lastly, Bayhead Pond, a storm water retention park complete with fish release was made possible by a donation from the Florida Wildlife commission. This park is 1.3 mile asphalt loop, thousands of plants, trees, benches, picnic tables and 2 connecting ponds. Turtles bask on grassy banks, ducks both Muscovy and Mallard enjoy the good life.




