DID YOU KNOW? Your Right to Sell Your Home

Florida Statute Chapter 723.058, was enacted in 1984 provides that:

(1) "No mobile home park owner of subdivision developer shall make or enforce any "Rule, Regulation or Rental Agreement" which denies or abridges the right of any mobile home owner or owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision to sell his or her mobile home within the park or mobile home subdivision; which prohibits the mobile home owner or the owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision from placing a "For Sale" sign on or in his or her mobile home (except that the size, placement and character of all signs are subject to the properly promulgated and reasonable rules and regulations of the mobile home park or mobile home subdivision); or which requires the mobile home owner or the owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision to remove the mobile home from the park or mobile home subdivision solely on the basis of the sale thereof

(2) The park owner of subdivision developer shall not exact a commission or fee with respect to the price realized by the seller unless the park owner or subdivision developer has acted as agent for the mobile home owner or the owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision in the sale pursuant to a written contract.

Florida Statute Chapter 723.061(2)(e) actually says:

Failure of the purchaser (not a prospective purchaser as the entry sign says), prospective tenant, or occupant of a mobile home situated in the mobile home park to be qualified as, and to obtain approval to become

a tenant or occupant of the home, if such approval is required by a properly promulgated rule.

Tip #11 Month of November

For those of you who have garbage disposals (for the Canadians that would be your "garbarator) in your sinks, this may be a help. Many times a call will go out from someone who cannot get it to work, and have a sink that is full of water & won't empty. You try all kinds of things, but it just won't turn on.

Well somewhere probably under your sink is a funny looking tool that comes with the machine when you buy it. Most people forget what it is & what it's for, but it is a special wrench to free up the gears that are clogged with some kind of junk that should not have been put in the sink to start with. Once you use this tool (with power off please) you can feel the motor turn freely. If it still will not turn with the switch, before thinking about calling a plumber or replacing the unit, - - - There is a re-set button on the bottom too. It is a mini circuit breaker for the unit that keeps the motor from overheating. Press the re-set, and most of the time you are ready to go.

VETERAN'S CORNER TRICARE RX NETWORK CHANGES

Express Scripts, Inc. (ESI) has upcoming changes to the retail pharmacy network it manages on behalf of TRICARE. On Dec. 1, 2016, Walgreens pharmacy locations will join the network, and CVS pharmacies, including those in Target stores, will leave the network. The new network will have more than 57,000 locations nationwide. ESI is doing additional outreach to patients filling specialty drugs at CVS pharmacies to ensure they can move their prescription with no gap in their prescription coverage. If beneficiaries chose to fill a prescription at CVS after Dec. 1, it will be a non-network pharmacy. This means they will have to pay the full cost of the medication upfront, and file for partial reimbursement. For more information, visit the Express Scripts, Inc. (ESI)

DOGS FOR VETERANS

The nonprofit organization Rebuilding Warriors provides highly trained and socialized Service/companion Dogs to honorably discharged veterans diagnosed as amputees as well as those with PTSD, (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder) and TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury). The organization has given dozens of dogs to veterans in seven states. The organization also needs people willing to raise puppies that will eventually become service dogs.

VETERANS CRISIS LINE

When someone calls the Veterans Crisis Line, they are prompted to "press 1" if they're a veteran. The call is then answered by a trained professional at a VA-run call center. If the call is not answered in 30 seconds, the call is then forwarded "rolled over" to one of the call centers part of the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline to ensure the veteran is connected with a trained professional. The personnel at these back-up call centers are all U.S.-based and trained

to handle callers in crisis. This "roll over" is put in place to ensure that Veterans are being connected to a crisis intervention responder when the VCL staff are assisting other Veterans. If you are in crisis, or know a veteran who is, The Veterans Crisis Line number is 1-800-273-8255 — then Press 1; or text to 838255; or chat on the Veterans Crisis Line website.


