

YOU NEED TO KNOW!

<u>2020 LHOA Membership Assessment Dues Payment:</u> Assessment dues are the only source of income to meet yearly expenses! LHOA is a Florida corporation and not able to do fundraising.

- ✓ The <u>deadline</u> for the 2020 membership <u>renewal</u> assessment dues for current 2019 Members is December 31st 2019. New homeowners and those who were previous Members are encouraged to join during this time period. This helps the Association out before the end of the year.
- ✓ Generally, new homeowners and previous Members have until mid-year to join as there is not a pro-rated payment. Join Early and attend meetings. Call a Director too. Board listings are in the "Voice" and on the bulletin board in the laundry room.
- ✓ LHOA has started accepting assessment dues on October 1st for 2020. The current annual assessment is \$15. This money allows the Association to conduct itself as required by F.S Chapter 723 for the benefit of both owners and members. Without these funds, the Association will cease to exist. LHOA will have representatives at the weekly coffee on Wednesday mornings. Payment can also be made directly to the Membership Committee Chairman at Lot 112 or the Secretary at Lot 1438, at BOD meetings and all Member meetings that start in December. If paying by check please make payable to LHOA. *New members will need to complete a short membership form.

<u>Tentative LHOA Directors monthly meeting schedule:</u> Sunday's at 4:30 PM in the clubhouse. 10/13/19; 11/3/19; 12/8/2019; 1/12/2020; 2/9/2020; 3/8/2020; (Additional meetings as needed). Board of Director meetings are open meetings and Association members may attend.

<u>LHOA Member Meetings:</u> Held in January, February and March, on Tuesday evenings at 7 PM in the clubhouse. The February 18th meeting is the Annual Meeting and Director Election Meeting.

<u>LHOA Town Hall Meeting(s)</u>: Any homeowner can attend this meeting. It is held to provide a general activity update and provide answers to homeowners' questions. Typically, there is a speaker to present various topics of homeowner interest. This meeting will be help on December 17, 2019 in the Clubhouse.

NOTE OF INTEREST

<u>Homeowners' Use Rights:</u> Chapter 723 of the Florida Statutes was created by the Florida legislature to provide a disciplined procedure for the development of a mobile home park.

In 723.054, requirements placed on the developer/park owner which grant to the park lot renter certain rights and privileges. Specifically:

1. The right to assemble (peacefully).

- 2. The right to use park amenities.
- 3. The right to purchase the park (right of first refusal), subject to certain conditions.
- 4. The right to have the park owner (your landlord) explain the material reasons for a rent increase.
- 5. The right to take certain issues to mediation.

<u>Remember</u> - The park owner (land lord) is not under <u>any</u> obligation to interact with a homeowner (lessee) or tenant. The park owner is <u>required</u> by Chapter 723.037(4)(b) to meet with a homeowners' committee (LHOA) on specific issues such as a "<u>Reduction in Services or Utilities</u>", "Sale of the Park" when a change of use is involved, "Rent Increases" and "Pass-on or Pass through Charges" and changes in the "Rules and Regulations".

Knowledge and understanding of the community and environment in which we live (year round or seasonal) is important in being able to live and enjoy our investment and understand the Lincolnshire community. Join and maintain your LHOA Membership. It is important in keeping your voice and vote alive. If you have questions, contact an Association Director who can give you answers or direct you to those that can.

LHOA has been in existence for 25 years! Board meetings are generally monthly and Member meetings are monthly from December to March. Members are strongly encouraged to attend.

his is an update from a series of 4 on diabetes, causes, nutrition, medications and exercise I ran last fall. The holidays are coming upon us again, fast filled with activities at the clubhouse and house parties. Not to mention all the baked goods from wonderful regional recipes. It is certainly not my intention to put any damper on any of these great times. However, nurses including yours truly just can't resist helping people understanding the laws of nature when eating and exercise are challenged.

For over half of my 40+ years as an RN I have tried to assist people including myself to understand how much of what we eat and what we then do with it lends to a healthier and safer life.

When I provided classes to diabetics whether they just graduated to the disease or struggling for some control I offered 3 sessions. First class was to understand how our body was designed to survive using food many thousands of years ago in human history, what has happened recently to challenge how we as humans were designed including what diabetes is. Lastly how medications, managing our meals and simple exercise (movement) have such a central role in feeling so much better. "Why am I so tired after I eat, I got 8 hours of sleep last night." "I started a new diabetes medication and I feel lousy." "I will just eat less or one big meal and that will help." And so, so many others. Losing control of our blood sugar (needed by every living cell in our body even fat for energy) is often utterly frustrating.



VETERAN'S CORNER

1. A nationwide smoking ban outside all Department of Veterans Affairs medical facilities applying to visitors, patients and employees is creating controversy. A third of veteran's smoke, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and many were introduced to



- the habit while serving. Tobacco long has been tied to military: Cigarette ads featured troops, and the culture of the service historically promoted smoking on the battlefield or as a welcome respite from the stress of combat.
- 2. Smoking was already prohibited inside VA medical buildings, but now patients, employees and visitors will not be able to puff away anywhere on the grounds. Previously, smoking was allowed in designated shelters dotting the grounds of VA medical facilities. Posters and banners promoting the ban have been put up in facilities and the VA is alerting veterans through social media and letters. "This is a really good thing for our veterans and our staff," said Kevin Forrest, associate director of the Manchester VA in New Hampshire, which serves 27,000 veterans. "It's a safer environment. It reduces fire risk. There is certainly evidence that smoking and second-hand exposure is a medical risk for our veterans."
- 3. The smoking ban was first announced this summer. It brings the facilities in line with bans already in place at 4,000 medical facilities and four national health care systems that have made their grounds smoke-free. But some veterans see the move as draconian.

4. Regardless of pushback, the ban is happening. Over the coming months, it is gradually implementing the ban for the 62,000 veterans it serves, including providing resources that could help veterans kick the habit. Violators will initially be warned of the policy and eventually VA police will enforce it. But even a gradual rollout is seen as too stringent for some smokers, even some veterans who don't smoke. They argue that there should be some place for smoking at VA facilities and fear that some veterans may choose cigarettes or cigars over visiting their VA doctors.




