n Memorial Day Week End Holiday, May 23-24, 2015 power interrupted again. Called Duke Energy, their investigation found one leg of the 120 volt was not maintained intact and operational. They wouldn't fix, advised I needed an electrician. They recommended nobody beyond looking in the yellow pages. Mind you now, the temperature outside was and

had been running in the ninety degree range most all the time. I was exposed to food spoilage and no operational Air Conditioning. This is still on the holiday week end, and unable to get any Commercial Electrical people for emergency assistance. With my former knowledge of a licensed electrical person I called and he came to my assistance and did a temporary electrical fix. He found that both Lincolnshire Pedestal circuit breakers were in failure, with one having the breaker being blown apart, and the other heavily burned and unworkable. It was strange when I watched Duke

Energy Field Service reset the circuit breaker and this condition was not found. Also, he found that the continuity of the main underground cable was with an open circuit and not able to carry current. This outcome does not say much for the Duke Energy Field Service as not finding this failure seems to say they cannot do much beyond flipping a switch, as that's all they know. This meant, the underground cable would require replacement. With his work load and inability to acquire the necessary electrical components repairs were not completed until several days later.

Now this lightning story has just made this first and second chapters, the third chapter, came up on July 28th.2015 with a major roof leak in my main bath room ceiling area. My roof area was replaced in 2012 with a new roof over using the lament type or flat insulating covering material. This material is non-flammable, thank god. My call to the installing personnel found a BURNED HOLE THE SIZE OF QUARTER TO FIFTY CENT PIECE IN THE ROOF AREA ABOVE MY BATH ROOM. Further, examination upon repair disclosed the insulation was melted, deformed, along with a BIG HOLE MELTED INTO THE ORIGINAL ALUMINUM METAL TOP CAP. SINCE ALL THIS AREA WAS NON-FLAMMABLE MATERIAL THE HEAT FROM THE LIGHTNING MELTED RATHER THAN FLAMED UP AND BURNED. The roof leak has been repaired between rain sessions and is keeping it perfectly dry as required. In conclusion, readers may ask and want to know about INSURANCE REIMBURSEMENT FOR CLAIM DAMAGE.

Well folks, if your carrier is the Citizens Insurance Company, and the Agent is O.E. Wilson, forget it, Advice to the Citizens Insurance covered nothing towards my loss in value of the computer and DVD-VHS even meeting the deductible contract clause, the Agent would do nothing. My final analysis for insurance is now called SELF-INSURANCE. I did not renew the policy. I'll take my chances with Mother Nature again as she was good to me and did not burn me out, and could have if not for some non-flammable roof material. As for our Park Owners, Park Manager and any others associated with the Owners Park Prospectus this incident bought out some deficiencies in that publication with no resulting action to date, not even as much as an acknowledgement receipt as to the problem and information thereto.

My end of this Lightning Story is still unavoidable, it has been said lightning doesn't strike in the same place twice.

I will keep that in mind when the next storm passes through!! Staying well and safe from all perils, even lightning, can be and is a chore in any Mobile Home Coach in Florida our lightning capital of the world.

fter just remembering those who were lost in the attack on the World Trade Center attack, it is good to reflect on some of the survival stories that emerged.

Let this is a story about Daisy, a golden retriever who was a service dog for a blind man named James Crane. He worked on the 101st floor of Tower 1 of the World Trade Center.



After the plane hit 20 stories below, James knew that he was doomed, so he let Daisy go, out of an act of love. She darted away into the darkened hallway. Choking on the fumes of the jet fuel and the smoke James was just waiting to die. About 30 minutes later, Daisy comes back along with James' boss, Who Daisy just happened to pick up on floor 112 on her first run of the building, she leads James, James' boss, and about 300 more people out of the doomed building.

But she wasn't through yet, she knew there were others who were trapped. So, highly against James' wishes she ran back in the building. On her second run, she saved 392 lives. Again she went back in. During this run, the building collapses. James hears about this and fallscontinued on page 35


