



Did you know??

DID YOU KNOW? MOBILE HOME OWNERS HAVE RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES INDER FLORIDA LAW.

Florida Statute Chapter 723.023 provides for the Mobile Home Owner's General Obligations. It exists under Title XL and covers "REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY MOBILE HOME TENANCIES". It reads as follows:

723.23 Mobile home owner's general obligations. A mobile home owner shall at all times:

- (1) Comply with all obligations imposed on mobile home owners by applicable provisions of building, housing, and health codes, including compliance with all building permits and construction requirements for construction on the mobile home and lot. The home owner is responsible for all fines imposed by the local government for noncompliance with any local codes.
- (2) Keep the mobile home lot which he or she occupies clean, neat, and sanitary, and maintained in compliance with all local codes.
- (3) Comply with properly promulgated park rules and regulations and require other persons on the premises with his or her consent to comply with such rules and to conduct themselves, and other persons on the premises with his or her consent, in a manner that does not unreasonably disturb other residents of the park or constitute a breach of the peace.

<u>"Properly Promulgated Park Rules"</u> means those "Rules" that have been submitted to the State of Florida and have been approved, by the state. Any other "Rule" is known as a "Defacto" Rule and is **NOT** enforceable as a matter of law.

The Handy Hubby

Tip #10 Month of October

This one is for those who are returning for the "season" and even more important – those who live alone, and may not use all of the plumbing fixtures in their homes regularly.

First for those who are returning: If you have had your water turned off while you were gone, when you turn it back on – do it slowly. Crack the valves a little to allow built up air pockets to empty before opening the main valve completely. Then be sure to run water into your empty drains to fill the traps. Then check for leaking, as some parts may have dried out without water in them, and will crack and may need replacement to end new leaks. It is also a good idea if you have had your water turned off for more than 2 or 3 months, to run water through your hot water heater before turning it on. Run it through for about 30 minutes to "clean-out" the old water which could have a build-up of sulfur from old water evaporating in the unit. (Often found in Florida water, even that which has been treated).

For those who live alone. Make sure you run water into all the drains at least once each month to keep the traps full of water. This prevents pests from entering the home through the drain pipes, and sewer gases from backing up into the home.

Fall Vegetable and Herb Gardening

This has been my first summer as a retiree. I had a lot of plans and got a lot of suggestions form friends that are already there, had lots of ideas and I do intend to get to them, but for now let's just say it was restful One thing I did try my hand at, because I have always enjoyed doing it, is vegetable gardening. So what I'm going to do is share some of my experiments and successes.

The first thing I had to decide was what was I going to try to grow in Florida's heat of the early summer, and then how and where on my lot could I do it. I didn't invest a lot, in fact I got a lot of my seeds and starter cups at target in the bullet's playground section. They sometimes sell this kind of stuff. I got parsley, thyme, rosemary, sweet green peppers, and sweet basil. You get the growing medium and a small pack of seed. I followed the directions, and put them on the west side for afternoon sun. Within 4 days the seedlings were already popping up. I transplanted them to the gardening area when they got 3" high.

Now I had to grow my little garden in my patio area on the east side of my place. I decided to use window box type planters about 24" x 6" I used miracle grow soil. It helps hold the moisture. I had to really be careful that they didn't get too much sun, as the temps were already high and watch carefully that the soil stayed moist. Since I don't have any shade around my place, I used a market umbrella for that. I was able to grow and harvest green peppers from about 4 plants, gathered parsley, fresh basil and thyme, all from seed.

This fall I am planning to expand a little with a larger patio style box. You can get them at Lowes or Home Depot Some even come with wheels. I am planning herbs, among them sweet basil, and parsley, and also some tomatoes and leaf lettuce. Maybe some radishes.....You can start your plants form seeds, or buy young plants at nurseries or the big box stores

Call me if you need help with tomato planting information.

There is nothing like your own fresh food, and it is also fun to do and takes only as much time as you want to put into it.


