Members and non-members please read.

In view of recent events the Lincolnshire Homeowners' Association (LHOA) wants all members and homeowners to be aware that the LHOA is a "Voluntary Homeowners' Association". The Florida Statutes, Chapter 723 strictly provides what the LHOA "Can and Cannot" do.

LHOA is:

- Not allowed to intervene, be involved in or represent an individual homeowner with issues relative to the Park Owner's Prospectus(s) or the Park's Rules and Regulations. Any issues an individual has with the Park Management or the Park Owner, with regard to Federal or State Law or Regulations, the Park Prospectus, the Park's Rules and Regulations or Park Policy are issues solely between the individual homeowner and the owner of the park and park management.
- Is governed by Florida Statute, Chapter 723.037 gives the right to homeowner's to create a committee (LHOA) to meet with the Park Owner to discuss those issues outlined in the chapter and requires the Park Owner to meet and discuss those named issues. The LHOA



does not have any right to become involved in the management of the park or right be involved in the decisions and actions of the Park Owner or Park Management.

Most non-community association practicing attorneys and federal or state agencies or representatives do not have any experience with a rental park's voluntary HOA *and* that there is a difference between "Mandatory" and "Non-Mandatory" Associations. They assume all HOA's are entities that manage and make park decisions.

Therefore, when a homeowner files a complaint with a government agency or files a legal suit that <u>person must ensure there is an understanding that the HOA has no legal standing</u>. They can call the LHOA President and should.

WHY DOES IT MATTER?

- Your HOA has to seek legal counsel and take the action(s) required by the complaint or suit for removal or dismissal. <u>Each and every time.</u>
- This is several hours of work and **great legal expense** for <u>each</u> occurrence. HOA Members pay a yearly membership assessment to fund the required statutorily mandated requirements. Non-members have paid nothing. Association members, from all 15 streets bare the legal expense which is incurred when the LHOA is misrepresented.

The LHOA Board of Directors has and will continue to listen to the member's issues and provide information, direction and assistance. The LHOA is a library of information and resources for members.

<u>In Summary</u>, Your LHOA has mandates, established by law, that are focused on being prepared for the <u>"Purchase of the park - under certain conditions" and "Meeting yearly with the park owner relative to issues of "Rent increase, Property tax pass-on and "Maintenance issues" affecting a majority of homeowners.</u>

<u>What to do</u>. When we exercise our rights as citizens and homeowners please ensure whoever we have sought to assist us understands the limitations of our HOA. It is the right thing to do.

2020 LHOA Membership drive starts October 1st through December 31st. The LHOA Board of Directors has 2 Director openings. If interested, please contact the President of the Board and become a service to our community.

LHOA has been in existence for 25 years! Board meetings are generally monthly and Member meetings are monthly from December to March. Members are strongly encouraged to attend.

i; Back again. Boy it sure has been hot! I hear in other parts of the country that it is nice and cool at night now. But here it is still summer, yes even though it's early October. Mom still has to be careful when she stops to talk outside with people that I don't stand too long on the hot pavement. I can burn my footpads!! Since I am seeing a lot of new pups around the park and some of them are new to Florida, I thought we should go over what to look for when being outside with us on a hot sunny Florida day.

HEAT STROKE

My normal temp is about 100-103F. When I run around my temp increases just like you. BUT I don't sweat like you do and I can quickly overheat. If panting can't bring my temp down heatstroke can occur. Heat stroke affects the entire body, and without quick treatment, it can quickly cause shock, coma, and death.

* What to look for: Rapid panting, bright red tongue, red or pale gums, thick, sticky saliva, weakness, dizziness, vomiting and or diarrhea.

*What to do: Heat stroke is a medical emergency and must be treated immediately! Soak your dog with lukewarm water(NEVER COLD) and cover us with water soaked towels on the way to the vet clinic. Cooling the body too quickly can be extremely harmful, which is why you never put cold water or ice on a dog with heat stroke.

So on these last weeks of summer, don't leave me in a car, even for a few minutes, just like those little kids.

And last, make sure I always have fresh, clean water. Don't leave me outside unshaded. Limit my exercise outside to early morning and evenings.

Enjoy summer and Florida fall- have fun with me but keep me safe.



We have to adapt and overcome with beating the heart. After 65, our bodies just can't adjust to changes in temperature, especially heat, as quickly. Some of us have chronic medical conditions requiring medications that can also interfere with self-regulation. Ask your doctor if your medications get in the way of avoiding overheating. The inserts that come with your medications can also help. Diuretics can make it hard to stay hydrated. Diabetics and those with congestive heart failure must be especially aware and take the necessary steps to stay safe in the summer Florida heat.

Have your own strategy for staying comfortable in the heat throughout the year, though especially from May to October. The following are good actions to take (really for everyone.)

- ✓ Be well hydrated: lots of water and natural juices (caution if diabetic); be sensible with alcoholic beverages, coffee, tea and sodas (diet too!). Frozen and cold beverages help cool us from the inside. If you haven't peed in 4 hours go get a glass of water, now! Now!
- ✓ Cool baths and showers can help especially in the late afternoon when we all could use a cool dip. Go to the pool, get wet and then sit in the shade. Usually a gulf breeze helps.
- ✓ Stay in the shade as the afternoon hours between 12:00 and 5:00 pm are the hottest times of day.
- ✓ Stay cool inside. Keep shades angled to keep out much of the sun. There are many products that can prevent the heat from getting in our homes.
- ✓ Keep electric lights off or turned down and reduce oven/stove use. Often the kitchens in the Old South were outside. Not now!! What we eat can also help us stay more comfortable. Refrigerated foods like salads, fresh fruits and vegetables are a good source of water too. Double BoGo!
- ✓ Pay attention to what clothes we have on. Light and loose knit clothes are cooler. Cotton is very good. Let our clothes help our skin breath. And protect us from the sun.

There are a number of public and private agencies to assist seniors who are unable to keep up with the utility bills. You do have to establish a need for help. Often having the same amount each month makes it easier to budget. Duke Energy has such a plan.

Stay cooler my friends.

- 3. On Jan 1 Millions more will be eligible to use <u>Commissaries</u> that sell discounted groceries. Military exchanges that sell a variety of items ranging from clothing and shoes to toys, furniture, home appliances and electronics. They have on-base gas stations and stores that sell alcoholic beverages.
- 4. This newly eligible population will also be able to use certain morale, welfare and recreational, or MWR, facilities such as golf courses, movie theaters, clubs and certain other programs and facilities that are self-sufficient, generating enough revenue through fees and/or sales to pay their operating costs.
- 5. The departments of Veterans Affairs, Defense and Homeland Security have been working together for months on plans for how the program will be implemented. A crucial part of that is the credential required to get onto the base and to shop at the stores, because most veterans who aren't retired don't have access to installations.
- 6. Defense officials are working to enable technology at the front gate to scan those veteran cards so veterans can get in to use those benefits. Commissary officials are working on adjusting their technology to enable systems to read the cards.
- 7. Some veterans have said they are eligible for the new benefits because of their disability rating, but don't qualify for the VHIC, for various reasons. One veteran said she has tried to get answers from VA about what she can do to be able to shop, but has been unsuccessful. "I hope the VA and DoD will work together to ensure that no veterans with a service-connected disability are overlooked on this benefit," said the veteran, who asked to remain anonymous.
- 8. "The Veteran Health Identification Card, (VHIC), is the only credential that DoD resale and MWR facilities will accept from veterans authorized privileges solely under the Purple Heart and Disabled Veterans Equal Access Act of 2018," said DoD spokeswoman Jessica Maxwell. "Specific questions about who can and how to obtain a VHIC should be directed to the Department of Veterans Affairs." For their part, VA officials say DoD is in charge of this benefit expansion. "We are working with DoD to accommodate all eligible veterans," said VA spokesman Randy Noller.
- 9. For veteran caregivers who are newly eligible, the process will be different, initially, since caregivers aren't directly affiliated with DoD or VA, other than through the annual appointment to be a caregiver. The benefit applies to the primary caregiver of wounded/injured veterans who are registered in the VA caregiver program. The VA will post a memo to <u>VA.gov</u> for caregivers, to be used for access at the front gate, along with driver's license or other authorized form of ID. The VA process will later transition to a caregiver-type ID card, which will have scanning swipe capability.
- 10. The VHIC is issued only to veterans who are enrolled in the VA health care system, according to the VA website. You can complete an application by telephone by calling


