



#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

By this printing all homeowners would have received the yearly notice from the park owner concerning rent, compactor fee and the property tax pass-through charge. The property tax pass-through is allowed by Florida statutes for rental mobile home parks like Lincolnshire. This has been in existence for several years. Each homeowner is responsible for 1/464th of the total difference in the property tax from the basis year of 2006. Our park owner makes the charge to each homeowner once a year in July along with the rental increases while other owners may blend it into the rental increase or have 12 month installments. Property taxes are based on the value of the property (including the land) owned and is assessed by local or municipal governments. Resident owned parks also see increases and those charges are seen in increased maintenance fees. The Board is surprised by the number of new homeowners who have no knowledge of this pass-through tax until they receive the yearly notice. Your Board of Directors ensures that this pass-through is calculated correctly each year.

The Board will also exercise the right by Florida statute to schedule a meeting with the park owner or his representative concerning the rental increase notice and other issues deemed important to affected homeowners. This meeting must occur before the rental increase takes effect on July 1st.

#### Take Command: Changes Coming to the TRICARE Retiree Dental Program

- 1. Do you have <u>TRICARE Retiree Dental Program</u> (TRDP) coverage? If so, you need to know that the TRDP will end on December 31, 2018. But, don't worry. Anyone who was in TRDP this year, or who would have been eligible for the TRDP plan, will be able to choose a dental plan from among 10 dental carriers in the <u>Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance</u> <u>Program</u> (FEDVIP). You can begin reviewing program options now at <u>www.opm.gov/fedvip</u>. You'll be able to enroll in FEDVIP during the 2018 Federal Benefits Open Season, which runs from November 12 to December 10, 2018; coverage will begin on January 1, 2019.
- 2. Previously, FEDVIP wasn't available to Department of Defense beneficiaries, but it will now be available to those who would have been eligible for TRDP. As an added bonus, they will also be able to enroll in FEDVIP vision coverage, along with most active duty family members.
- 3. More than 3.3 million people are currently covered by FEDVIP. You can choose from dental plans offered by 10 different carriers. To enroll in FEDVIP Vision, you must be enrolled in a <u>TRICARE health plan</u>. You can decide if one of four vision plans meets your family's needs.
- 4. You may only enroll in a FEDVIP plan outside of open season if you experience a <u>Qualify-ing Life Event</u> that allows you to do so. Any election in a FEDVIP plan remains in effect for the entire calendar year.
- 5. For more information, visit the <u>FEDVIP website</u> at <u>https://tricare.benefeds.com</u> and sign up for email notifications. You'll get an email when new information is available and key dates approach. Future updates will include eligibility information, plans, carriers, rates, educational webinars and more.

#### Reporting the death of a retiree

Reporting the death of a retiree can be a difficult task for family or friends. We know that waiting on the phone and talking to one of our customer service representatives is not high on the priority list right after someone passes away. DFAS has re-introduced the option to report the death of a retiree online.

To use the online Notice of Death option, click on the link at the top of the Retired Military & Annuitants main page, which is located at <u>https://www.dfas.mil/retiredmilitary.html</u>. This will take you to a form where you will enter all of the pertinent information. When reporting a retiree's death, be sure to have the following information available:

Retiree's full name Retiree's SSN The date of death Cause of death Marital status If married, the wedding date

The form also asks for your name, address, phone number and email address. If you are completing this form on behalf of someone else, such as the spouse or child of the deceased retiree, please use the contact information of the person you are helping to make the report.

Updates on the status of the claim will be sent to the email address provided, including an email verifying that the notification was received.

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the <u>U.S Digital Service</u> have announced their launch of an improved <u>Appeals Status</u> tool to increase transparency and enable veterans to track the progress of their benefits claims appeals. The tool, which went live March 21 on VA's <u>Vets.gov website</u>, will allow Veterans to access detailed information about the status of their benefits appeals and will include alerts about needed actions, as well as estimates of how long each step of the process takes. Some Veterans who have previewed the new tool said it had given them hope and helped them understand that the process might take longer than expected.
