

- 1. Oak Crest / Acorn in over 30 years has Never Had Speed Bumps or Humps
- 2. The Stop Signs Are Enforceable by the Sheriff if management invites them in to watch for cars speeding or going thru them. Call management and ask them to request this. Let them know what times and areas you feel are the worst.
- 3. If you know who the people are that go thru the signs or speed, report it to the office, only then can they contact the person and let them know they have been witnessed speeding or blowing thru a stop sign,
- 4. If you feel you can not speak to management, call your HOA President 828-230-7249 and inform her of your report. Keep a ledger of what you are reporting if you can for future reference. Take photos or videos if possible.

- 9. If management Evicted someone it can take time, due to Laws in place to protect the resident. So you have to be patient at times, but keep reporting it to the office and the sheriff, if Laws are broken. the person may be able to be arrested, which speeds up the eviction process.

Happy Labor Day

The first Monday in September is a creation of the labor movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. It constitutes a yearly National tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity and the well being of our country.

More than a century after the first Labor Day observance there is still some doubt as to who first proposed the holiday for workers.

Some records show that Peter McGuire, general of the brotherhood of carpenters And joiners and a co-founder of the American Federation of Labor was first suggesting A day to honor those "who from rude nature have delved and carved all the grandeur we Behold." But Peter McGuire's place in Labor Day history has not gone unchallenged. Many believe that Matthew Maguire, a machinist, founded the holiday. Recent research Seems to support the contention that Matthew Maguire, late the secretary of Local 344 of The International Association of Machinist in Peterson, N.J. proposed the holiday

In 1882 while serving as a secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.

What is clear is that the CLU adopted a Labor Day proposal and appointed a committee to Plan a demonstration and picnic. The First Labor Day was celebrated on Tuesday,

September 5th, 1882 in New York City in accordance with the plans of the CLU. By 1894,

23 more states had adopted the holiday, and on June 28, 1894, President Grover Cleveland Signed a law making the first Monday in September of each year a national holiday.

The vital force of Labor added to the highest standard of living and the greatest Production the world has ever known and has brought us closer to the realization Of our traditional ideals of economic and political democracy.

It is appropriate, therefore, that the nation pays tribute on Labor Day to the creator Of so much of the nation's strength, freedom and leadership—

Then governors ordered businesses closed and told citizens to stay home To combat COVID-19, they refused to heed the presidents warning. In April, Trump said the cure couldn't be worse than the disease. Yet for many Americans, that's precisely the case. Not only are millions of Americans out of work, businesses that closed their doors in March, at no fault of their own, paid the ultimate price.

In a new report by Yelp, between 55% and 60% of the businesses on its website that were listed as closed temporarily are now permanently out of business, It's not just small businesses, either, Larger companies struggled to stay afloat due to social distancing restrictions and fearful consumers, as well. According to Yelp, the largest number of permanent closures are in California, New York, and Texas. They're also the states currently experiencing some Of the highest infection and hospitalization rates. Only 24% of the businesses that closed in March and April nationwide have reopened.

Restaurants were the most affected with 26.160 permanent closures Retail stores were second with 26.119.

As of July 10th over 132,500 businesses were still marked as closed on Yelp's platform. AS some states put new restrictions in place, THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC IS FAR FROM OVER







RECIPES FOR THE MONTH

ANGEL HAIR PASTA WITH SHRIMP AND BROCCOLI

Ingredients:

- 8 MEDIUM SHRIMP
- 3 LARGE GARLIC CLOVES
- 1/2/ TSP SALT AND PEPPER
- 6 TBSP OLIVE OIL
- 6 TBSP BUTTER
- 1 BUNCH OF BROCCOLI CUT UP
- 8 OZ.OF ANGEL HAIR.

Directions:

Toss together; shrimp garlic salt and pepper olive oil, marinade the shrimp for 3 hours in the fridge .After marinating, remove the garlic pieces ad 3 tbls butter. In a large saucepan add broccoli and bring to a boil. DRAIN AND RETURN TO SAUCEPAN AND COVER.

Heat 2 tbls olive oil and butter, add shrimp and saute' tossing often.

Cook pasta, drain and toss everything together.

DILLED HALIBUT STEAKS

Ingredients:

- 3/4 lbs halibut steaks [1 inch thick] cut onto 2 serving pieces
- ½ teaspoon salt, 2 sprigs dill weed, 2 lemon slices, ¼ inch
- Thick, 2 tablespoons dry white wine or non-alcoholic wine.

Directions:

Heat oven to 400 degrees, spray 8-inch square glass baking dish with cooking spray, pat fish dry with paper towels and place fish in baking dish. Sprinkle fish with salt, place dill weed sprigs and lemon slice on each piece of fish and pour wine over fish.

Bake uncovered 20 to 25 minutes or until fish flakes easily with fork.



BANANA FOSTER WITH ICE CREAM

Ingredients:

- ¹/₄ cup caramel topping
- 1 teaspoon dark rum or ½ teaspoon Rum extract
- 1 banana, sliced
- 1 cup vanilla ice cream.

Directions:

In small microwavable bowl, microwave caramel topping And rum, uncovered on high for 15 seconds, or until Warm, stir banana, scoop ice cream into desert dishes.



Rosh Hashanah, Sept. 18–20. The Jewish New Year and the traditional anniversary of the creation of Adam and Eve, the first man and woman according to the Hebrew Bible, and the inauguration of humanity's role in God's world.

World Alzheimer's Day, Sept. 21. An international campaign to raise awareness and challenge the stigma that surrounds dementia.

The history of Labor Day

abor Day is a creation of the labor movement, a yearly celebration of the American worker, and a national tribute to the laborer's contribution to the social and economic achievements of the United States. There is some uncertainty about the origins of Labor Day. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a co-founder of the American Federation of Labor, was first to suggest a day to honor those "who from rude nature have delved and carved all the grandeur we behold." Other research suggests that machinist Matthew Maguire, later the secretary of Local 344 of the



International Association of Machinists in Paterson, N.J., proposed the holiday in 1882 while serving as secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. In 1884, the first Monday in September was selected as the official holiday. The first governmental recognition of Labor Day came through municipal ordinances passed in 1885 and 1886. The state of Oregon passed the first law recognizing the Labor Day holiday on Feb. 21, 1887. Four more states—Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York—followed suit that same year. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in all the states, the District of Columbia, and all U.S. territories.


