Board Adopts Resolution on Coronavirus Protocol at Palm Hill

On March 18, the Board of Directors adopted the following resolution regarding the Coronavirus situation:

Resolved with regard to the unfolding Coronavirus event that the following protocols and procedures be adopted:

A. **Building, Facility, Event and Activity Closures and Restrictions:** The Park Manager will consult local, state, and federal (Centers for Disease Control (CDC) health officials and offices as appropriate for guidance. Park Manager will recommend to the Board preferred courses of action, but is authorized to close facilities or cancel events and activities if he believes that such action is required by the circumstances. Additionally, he is authorized to restore and re-open buildings and or activities. The Park Manager should also consult legal counsel for any advice as needed. The Park Manager will be Palm Hill's point of contact and will establish a point of contact with local health officials.

B. **Notifying the CDC and Local Health Officials**: If it is learned that a resident is infected or the community has otherwise been exposed to an infected person, the Park Manager shall promptly notify all appropriate local, state, and federal health officials and follow guidance as appropriate.

C. **Personnel and Workforce impacts:** The Park Manager shall keep the President and the Board promptly informed of any development or matter arising from the pandemic and impacting employee health and safety, or workforce requirements. Protocols with respect to interaction at the Park Office as well as any other setting where staff members interact with unit owners and vendors or visitors shall emphasize physical or social distancing between individuals.





MANAGER'S CORNER – PALM TREE BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT RENEWED

The Palm Trees Project to beautify Palm Hill began in 2017, but was halted last year due to a palm tree disease that was spreading around Florida. The project is now re-opened.

This year, plantings of Foxtail Palm trees will be done, starting in fiscal year 2021, probably in August. Residents who previously signed up for a tree in 2018 or 2019 will be receiving notification of dates for the start. Replacements will also be made for trees which needed removal in the last two years, and

there will be some tree plantings in the median strip of the Seminole entrance.

Residents who requested the tree planting will be responsible for future maintenance. (Reminder: Each shareholder's property extends halfway across the land between the homes.)

The Foxtail Palm – so known because its branches appear bushy like a fox's tail – is known for easy maintenance since it is said to be a 'self-cleaning" specimen, meaning that spent leaves will die and drop from the tree as needed to facilitate new growth. At maturity, this palm may reach a height of about 25 feet, a trunk diameter of a foot or less and a canopy of about 20 feet.

Board member Carolyn Story brought up the project renewal at the February 26th meeting of the board, which approved the budget for the project. The budget is subject to renewal each year. The cost per tree has been reduced to \$119 this year and includes installation. The Homeowners of Palm Hill Board has established a one-time \$7,000. allowance for this project, which will cover the cost.

A new sign up list will be available to interested shareholders after this project is completed, keeping in mind that this beautification project is subject to annual approval by the board for 2022.

REMOTE ATTENDANCE TECHNOLOGY FOR BOARD MEETINGS IN PLACE

The first use of technology to attend a Palm Hill governance meeting remotely was conducted at the March 18 Board of Directors meeting. Shareholders were able to call a number with their cell phones or land lines to get instructions to dial into an audio feed of the meeting. Further, some shareholders were able to download the Zoom app to enable video viewing of the meeting on their devices, said Chuck Silcox, Communications Committee member.

At the request of Craig Mayer, President of the Palm Hill Board of Directors, Silcox and fellow Communications Committee members Paul Myles, webmaster, and Jean Stjernstrom, website administrator, performed the testing in March that resulted in the first use of the technology at the board meeting. They will continue to work on this technology to enhance communications at Palm Hill.

"In this time of social isolation, this technology will enable people to avoid a large group meeting. They can stay in their homes, but also attend the Board of Directors meetings via Zoom technology," said Silcox. "It is a great leap forward for Palm Hill communications."

Instructions about how Zoom may be used will be on the Palm Hill website and sent out via broadcast emails by the Webmaster and the Communications Committee prior to meetings when it will be used.

MEETING NOTICES: To comply with Florida Statutes and increase transparency of Park management and governance, the Palm Hill webmaster is broadcasting by email notices of all board and committee meetings, as well as postings of minutes. Shareholders can thus follow park business and management in a timely manner, either in person at meetings, or through the minutes on the website. Information is also posted on the TV Channel 732. (Ch. 732 is not in the Spectrum cable guide. You must key 732 into the remote control device to get to the channel.)

ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF FORMER BOARD PRESIDENTS CREATED

The Board of Directors voted to appoint an advisory committee made up of former presidents of the Palm Hill Board.

"The purpose is to make available to the current board the combined experience and historical knowledge held by past presidents," said Mayer. One example is that the former presidents were asked to review and provide input on the new Policy and Governance Manual that was recently adopted by the board.

The advisory committee will be encouraged to meet once a year and communicate to the Board through any of the board officers.

"This collective bank of knowledge and perspective will be valuable as the Board governs and manages Palm Hill going forward," he said.







Carts with Red Flags MUST observe the 90-degree rule. Others in the cart who are not handicapped do not have the privilege of using the handicap status. Red Flag carts must observe all restrictions such as yellow lines and posted signs when approaching greens.

For those who need a *temporary* handicap flag, they may ask for a Yellow Flag at the Pro Shop. Yellow Flags must be returned at the end of play that day.






