available. Most folks are well aware of all the sources cited, but the rundown might be helpful to new residents, and a refresher course for the already well-informed can't hurt.

In no particular order of importance, here's a list of information sources in addition to The Link, and how to access them.

The Palm Hill website is at <u>www.palmhillcountryclub.net</u>. Everyone can visit the site's public section, but only Palm Hill shareholders can access the private area.

One of the most active areas of the website is the Message Board. There, shareholders exchange ideas, raise questions, express opinions, etc.

An area of the website that should attract more visits than it does is the Documents area. That area is designed to contain minutes of meetings of the Corporation's Board and Committees, among other items. The majority of Palm Hill's 1,096 shareholders don't attend those meetings. But they can get a general description of Corporation business by visiting the website and reading the minutes when they get posted.

There's a lot of other material on the website, too, and it's worth visiting frequently.

If you are a shareholder and have given your e-mail address to the Webmaster, you'll get e-mails on a variety of subjects, including notices of Board and Committee meetings. If you haven't given the webmaster your e-mail address, send it to phccwebmaster62@gmail.com.

While all the above information sources require some effort -- although generally minimal -- you can get Palm Hill information by doing what most of us do frequently without a second thought: turn on the TV. The Palm Hill channel is 732.

Don't overlook the bulletin boards in each of our two clubhouses. There is always a list of upcoming trips, notices about Palm Hill events and general information. Take some time to look the boards over.

And, then, there's the old-fashioned way: Oral announcements at the Monday and Wednesday coffees. Key information is provided there often, both official and unofficial.

The Link will continue to try to provide information when conditions make it possible to do so. But depend on these other sources, too, for they often do what The Link can't: provide the newest and latest information. The Link's deadline is three weeks before its distribution, so information in it is unavoidably dated.

NEW BUDGET APPROVED

he Board of Directors has approved a budget for 2018-2019 that increases Palm Hill's monthly maintenance fee to \$335, effective July 1.

The Board took the action at a meeting June 13. Prior to the Board's vote, the proposed budget had been presented to the Board, explained at a community meeting, and distributed by mail to all shareholders.

The new monthly fee is an increase of \$21 over the current \$314. Most shareholders can expect to see an offsetting decrease in their bills from Spectrum because of a newly negotiated contract with the television and internet service provider.

Under the new Spectrum agreement, residents will no longer pay Spectrum directly unless they buy services beyond those provided by the agreement.

The services provided by the new agreement are the following: 150 regular TV channels plus 10 Showtime channels, cable boxes for two TVs, high-speed internet, and a wi-fi modem.

How much each shareholder will save on the Spectrum bill to offset the maintenance fee increase depends on the amount the shareholder has been paying Spectrum.

About \$18 of the maintenance fee increase is attributable to the new Spectrum agreement.

Everyone received a letter from Spectrum in June stating what needed to be done as a result of the new agreement.

CRIME PREVENTION CLASS

n July 18 at the South Clubhouse there will be a crime prevention class presented by the Crime Prevention Task Force, a community service organization developed by former law enforcement officers.



The class will begin immediately after the regular Wednesday coffee, which should make start time for the class about 9:15 a.m.

The mission of the Crime Prevention Task Force is to create greater public awareness of criminal threats facing everyone in society today, and to present effective measures to counter those threats. The Task Force's message: No one needs to be afraid of being at home alone, or of going out to the supermarket.

Some of the topics to be covered: Identity Theft, Fraud and Scams, Guns and Alternative Weapons, Home Safety, Carjacking, and more.



or almost half a century, Palm Hill residents have been generously supporting RCS, contributing food to those in need. It seems appropriate to take an opportunity to present some information about the organization that might not be well known.

To begin with: The name "RCS" just rolls off the tongue. But maybe some of us have forgotten (or perhaps never knew) what the initials stand for: Religious Community Services.

RCS was established in 1967 when 15 local religious congregations of various faiths came together to provide help and hope to people in need in Pinellas County.

When Palm Hill was established a few years after that, some of the first Palm Hill residents -- Ellen Jensen and her husband -- became very involved with the RCS Food Bank through their church. Ellen soon began collecting food at the Clubhouse.

Palm Hill was expanded in the late 1970s, and an additional Clubhouse was built, and within a few years the RCS collection was taking place in both Clubhouses.

Today, in addition to the collections at the Clubhouses, there is an annual door-to-door food drive in which volunteers in golf carts drive through the community collecting donations and delivering them to an RCS truck brought in especially for the occasion. This is usually done in the latter part of March before snowbirds head home.

The Pilates and Line Dancing classes always ask their participants to bring one staple item for the RCS barrel. It's amazing how it all adds up.


Thanks to everyone for your participation in this worthwhile project. Each year we donate more food, yet more food is always needed.






