BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING


he Board of Directors took several actions at its meeting on June 5, among them the following:

The Board approved a budget for the fiscal year 2019-2020 that provides for an increase of \$34 in the monthly assessment, bringing the monthly figure to \$369.

The manager reported that late payments of the monthly assessment currently total approximately \$17,000.

The Board approved a proposal to carry out a beautification project of the Seminole entrance and to expand the seating capacity at the South pool.

The Board approved a rule change limiting to two the number of vehicles registered to a single address, with a provision that any current registrations in excess of that are excepted.

Another in a series in which third generation residents look back at what brought them to Palm Hill.

ad Jean Stjernstrom's grandfather not remarried, she and her husband, Tom Moriarty, might not be living in Palm Hill today.

Her grandparents, Ener and Hilda Enerson, spent their winters in a snowbird community a few miles from the citrus grove that eventually became Palm Hill, and Jean recalls coming down as a child from Minnesota to visit them in that community.

Jean's grandfather Ener remarried in 1980 and moved into the Palm Hill home of his new wife, Lee, at 65 Pindo Palm East.

At that point the site of the visits to her grandfather became Palm Hill. Her grandfather passed away in 1986.

"I remember the first time I came into Palm Hill, with my mother, on our way to visit my grandfather," Jean recalls. "It was about 1980 and I felt like the streets were confusing and a lot of construction was going on. I don't think it ever occurred to me that one day I might be living here."

But as time passed, "Tom and I talked about the possibility once in a while."

"On one visit, about 15 years ago, we met Pam Raymond (a real estate agent specializing in Palm Hill) and looked at a lot of places, but we didn't do anything more than look."

By 1999 Jean's parents -- Richard and Lillian Stjernstrom -- were retired and had become Palm Hill residents, living at 96 Thatch Palm West.

They left Palm Hill in 2016 and now live in an Assisted Living facility in Minnesota.

They're in their mid-90s, and "My mother still drives and they go out, a lot of time to the casino," Jean says.

When her parents left Palm Hill, Tom and Jean moved into the home at 96 Thatch Palm West that Jean's parents had occupied.

Now Tom and Jean live the snowbird life, spending about seven months here and the summer in Minnesota.

Jean, a former wireless network technician, has played a primary role in development of Palm Hill's website.

She is currently engrossed in scanning into computer format an estimated 20,000 photographs of her family and Tom's family.
