FOR THE RECORD: 2020 Election Results

wo new members joined the volunteer Board of Directors at the annual election January 23, and one board member was re-elected for another three-year term.

New board members Craig Mayer and Dave Kohli will each serve three years, with their terms expiring in 2023.

Carolyn Story was re-elected and will serve through 2023.

Each year, three members are elected to three-year terms, a schedule that provides continuity of knowledge, experience and leadership on the nine-member board.

At the January 24 board organizational meeting, Craig Mayer was elected President of the board, succeeding Bob Newport, who stepped down as president but remains on the board. Dave Kohli was elected Treasurer, succeeding Dan Avery in that position. Dan Avery did not run for reelection. Former member Mac McElhinney also stepped down from the board at the end of his term.

2020 officers elected at the January 24 organizational meeting:

President: Craig Mayer Vice President: Jack Russell Treasurer: Dave Kohli Secretary: Carolyn Story

Seven candidates ran for three seats. About 630 votes were cast. The results were:

Craig Mayer: 393 votes Dave Kohli: 366 votes Carolyn Story: 292 votes Cheryl Sienko: 260 votes Carey Bradburn: 249 votes Terry Brittain: 230 votes Linda Rodriguez: 80 votes



One ballot question was presented.

The question was whether the Board would have the power to use funds from the Reserve Fund during an emergency. The measure passed 305 to 79.



IT PAYS TO RECYCLE - REALLY!

Pictured, Morgan Crooks, owner of M&M Recycling of St. Petersburg, stands atop a load of metals she hauled away from the Palm Hill Sanitation Area. Palm Hill saves money through all the work done to separate, recycle and sell metals that end up in the Sanitation Field.

Rick Gregorio, Co-Chair of the Palm Hill Environmental Committee, reported that this one load of metal – at 3,540 pounds – saved Palm Hill \$315.24. Here's how: The city of Largo would have charged us \$188 to haul this load, and another \$56.25 to dispose it.

The proceeds from selling the metals netted Palm Hill \$71. That all adds up to \$315.24. And that is just one load. The hauls over a year's time can result in substantial savings to Palm Hill. In 2019, Rick Gregorio said the cost savings and metal sales amounted to more than \$4,000 – a savings to Palm Hill's bottom line.
