TV Communication Channels

Contact: A New Communication Chairperson each month.

ur current communication channels are 96, 98.1, & 732 The channel you use is dependent on the age of your TV. Older TV's will use channel 98, whereas newer TV's will use 98.1 or 732.

POSTING INFORMATION ON THE COMMUNICATION CHANNEL

We are making a change in our procedures which should simplify things, and make sure information gets posted in a timely manner. There are two ways for you to submit information to get posted:

- 1. The communication channel will always have the name of the person responsible for updating the system. This will allow you to deliver a hand written notice if desired.
- 2. We have established an E-Mail address that will be used exclusively for anyone who wishes to have a notice posted. The E-Mail address we will be using is: **phcctvcommunications@gmail.com**. If you wish to have your notice included in the next months Link, add the email address of the Link Editor, Leslie Baker at ljonedog@comcast.net. By using this E-Mail address your notice will always get to the person monitoring the system as well as the Link Editor. Do not send E-Mails to the personal E-Mail address of anyone responsible for updating the TV system.
