There has been some discussion recently about whether an increase in Palm Hill's share price would result in an increase in each homeowner's property tax. Some shareholders say it would, others say it wouldn't, and sometimes the discussions about it have grown heated.

The Link directed the question to the person in the best position to know: Pinellas County Property Appraiser Mike Tweety. Mr. Tweety graciously responded by sending Dina Meath, one of his residential appraisers who specializes in mobile home communities -- including Palm Hill -- to meet with The Link's editors.

Ms. Meath explained that the Property Appraiser's office doesn't decide how much property tax anyone pays. That's determined by taxing authorities. But the Property Appraiser's office provides a key element in the taxing authorities' calculation: the market value of the property.

Ms. Meath pointed out that the market value is calculated anew each year based on selling prices of comparable properties in the prior year. The selling price used by Ms. Meath is the total amount paid by the buyer, which in Palm Hill consists of two elements: part for the mobile home and part for the share.

She said an increase in the share price would not affect the market value, and offered this example to explain why: Suppose a Palm Hill property will bring \$100,000 on the market, and \$70,000 of that amount is for the mobile home itself and \$30,000 is for the share. Increasing the share to \$40,000 isn't likely to increase the selling price, she said. The property will continue to sell for \$100,000, because that's what the market will bear, but now \$60,000 will be for the mobile home and \$40,000 for the share.

So, the bottom line is this: There may be legitimate reasons to debate whether the Palm Hill share price should be increased, but concern that an increase in the share price would result in an increase in property taxes is not among them.

On another subject:

Nearby in this edition of The Link is the first in a series of articles featuring those who have been residents of Palm Hill the longest, those The Link editors are dubbing "Palm Hill Pioneers."

<u>RAIN</u>: We have had a lot of rain in August which has delayed several of the concrete projects. In addition the heavy rains have resulted in many (96 and counting) properties with weeds/grass growing in the planters or rock beds. We are contacting the homeowners to have them correct the violations.

<u>WESTCOAST LAWN SERVICE</u>: We recently met with one of the owners of Westcoast and the supervisor assigned to Palm Hill. Several items were discussed, including blowing carports out (not in), sweeper truck, no mow signs. If you do not want your yard mowed we have red flags at the office that you can place at the corners of your property which will alert the crew not to mow/weed whack your yard. Westcoast requires a 4 (four) foot buffer from the sides of the mobile home and around a/c units so the weed whackers do not hit the siding of the unit. There has been some confusion as to what the procedure is for blowing and sweeping. Grass cuttings will be blown back on the grass, the mowers all have mulching blades and the clippings are actually beneficial to the health of the lawn. Blowers are to blow carports out to the street which the sweeper will pick up. It is important to understand that the sweeper may not be right behind the blowers. If you have any issues, contact the office so we can alert Westcoast to the problem.

### **PALM HILL PIONEERS**

A series featuring some of those who have resided in Palm Hill the longest.

hen Suzy Hunt got her first glimpse of the large open space at the corner of Seminole and 8th, she exclaimed, "Oh, Lord, look at all those trailers!"

There were about 20 of "those trailers," clustered around what today is Frangipani Circle, placed there by entrepreneurs intent on developing a community of modular homes.

It was 1970, the year of Palm Hill's birth. And in October of that year, Suzy and her since-deceased husband, Bob McGuire, moved to 20 Frangipani Circle, where Suzy lives today at the age of 92. After Bob's death she married Claude Hunt, who died in 1991.

A major part of the sales pitch for the new community was the golf course, with free lifetime memberships.

"We bought, and I'm glad we did," Suzy says. "But the free golf membership got taken away after a while."

She believes that she and Bob were the 7th couple to move into Palm Hill. Not one of those couples is around today, so Suzy claims the title of Palm Hill's longest resident -- 49 years in October.

Adults of any age could live in Palm Hill then. The current age restrictions came later.

There were various growing pains, among them the fact that none of the first houses had registered addresses, and so the post office delivered everyone's mail to the sales office.

"We had to go there to get our mail," Suzy remembers. "Sometimes there was confusion, but we managed."

When Suzy moved in, there was -- in addition to the golf course -- a clubhouse, a small swimming pool and a hot tub.

She remembers taking advantage of the citrus trees around the golf course that had not yet been cleared, and picking grapefruit and oranges from them.

"The fruit was delicious," she recalls.

She played golf almost daily until about 1980, when she suffered a back injury that put an end to that.

Gradually, more houses were brought in, set up, sold, and occupied. The concept of modular homes turned into mobile homes, the clubhouse was expanded, other amenities were added, and a thriving community developed.

Then the southern section was added, another clubhouse was built, tennis courts joined the swimming pools, shuffleboard courts and other amenities.

"Now, Palm Hill is like a little city," Suzy says.

What she likes the most about Palm Hill: "It's constantly improving. Our management does a good job."

One of her fondest memories is the time when, about 20 years ago -- she's not sure of the exact date -- there was a mock wedding "between the North and the South" intended to more closely connect the sections of Palm Hill.

"A big tent was set up, and there was a bride and a groom, and music, and a lot of refreshments, all provided by the management," she recalls.

"It was a great idea, and a lot of fun, but it didn't do much. The two sections are still divided."

Her greatest hope for the future is simply this: "I want Palm Hill to continue as it is, and never be converted into condos."
