The channel you use is dependent on the age of your TV. Older TV's will use channel 98, whereas newer TV's will use 98.1 or 732.

#### Posting information on the communication channel:

Te are making a change in our procedure which should simplify things, and make sure information gets posted in a timely manner. There are two ways for you to submit information to get posted:

1. The communication channel will always have the name of the person responsible for updating the system. This will allow you to deliver a hand written notice if desired.

2. We have established an E-Mail address that will be used exclusively for anyone who wishes to have a notice posted. The E-Mail address we will be using is: **phcctvcommunications**@ **gmail.com**. By using this E-Mail address your notice will always get to the person monitoring the system. Do not send E-Mails to the personal E-Mail address of anyone responsible for updating the system. All personal E-Mails will be returned and advised to use the E-Mail as shown above.

#### **Projects:**

North Pool Salt System: The new salt system for the North Pool has been installed.

Mesco Shed: The Mesco Shed has been pressure washed, primed and painted. South Laundry A/C: The new A/C unit for the south laundry has been installed.

Timers for Clubhouses: Programmable Timers have been installed in both clubhouses to automatically turn the lights off, thus eliminating the need for the lock-up patrol.

Golf Cart Parking: Golf carts are to be parked in the unit's carport or on a pad constructed of pavers not to exceed 5 feet by 8 feet. Parking on the grass around the mobile is not permitted

Vehicle Parking: Residents are to park their vehicles in their carport. Street Parking is not permitted overnight. Please leave enough room when parked on the street so Emergency Vehicles can get through.

Flag Ettiquette: The United States Flag Code does not allow the flying of any other flag on the same flag pole or any pennant that depicts the American Flag along with any other country's flag being flown. You may fly 2 countries flags as long as they are on separate flagpoles, are the same size flags and are flown at the same height.

act: Many homeowners in Palm Hill are helping by recycling, but some are not.

Whatever recycled materials that are collected Thursday and Friday are compacted then hauled away by the City of Largo free of change. All trash/garbage that is collected Monday and Tuesday is compacted and we have to pay the City of Largo \$37.50 per ton to have it hauled away plus a fee of \$200 per haul.

Recycling saves Palm Hill money, and it is the right thing to do.

YOU can help our park ... All you have to do is have two waste baskets, one for trash/garbage and one for the following RECYCLED ITEMS. Here is what can be recycled ...

• Plastic: Look for the triangle on the bottom. #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 (Butter Tubs,

Fruit Containers, Plastic Cups, Yogurt Containers, etc., Any plastic container with the recycling numbers on the bottom)

- Mixed Paper
- Aluminum Foil and Trays
- Tin or Steel Food Cans

Note: You Cannot Recycle: Plastic Bags, Plastic Wrap, Styrofoam or Take Out Containers, or Table Scraps





#### **Dead Tree Removal in Palm Hill**

If you have a dead tree on your property and want to remove it, it is imperative that the following procedure be followed:

• First you need a permit from the Palm Hill office to remove a tree. You will need to fill out an exterior alteration form at the Office indicating removal of a dead tree along with a drawing of where the tree is in relation to your home.

• Next, our Manager, Rich Thomas will fill out a City of Largo permit request form and will fax it to the City of Largo.

• The City of Largo will send an inspector out who makes the final decision on removing the tree. The City of Largo issues the permit, and Rich Thomas will pick it up and advise you that the tree can be removed.

• Then, and only then, can you hire a contractor or make arrangements to have the tree removed from your property. The cost of the removal of the tree is the unit owner's responsibility.

• Once the tree is removed, then the City of Largo needs to be called and advised that the tree has been removed, and they will send an inspector to verify that it was the only tree removed.

M.E.S.C.O. is an outgrowth of the service club activity of the Palm Hill Masonic Square Club. They began in 1973, providing medical equipment to residents of Palm Hill free of charge for as long as they needed it. The Annual Los Vegas Night fundraiser began in 1977 in order to raise money to replace and add equipment to the inventory, and to support Shriners Hospitals for Children in Tampa.

The Square club also constructed the Vern Skinner Memorial Building on land donated by Park management, which still houses M.E.S.C.O. inventory. In 1979 the Square Club loaned
