UPDATE ON THE SPECTRUM PLAN

ear Resident of Paradise Island,
The new Bulk Billing system with Spectrum is now a reality, effective July 1. In order for you to take full advantage of this exciting deal, please follow the steps shown below for your current status.

IF YOU ARE A CURRENT SPECTRUM CUSTOMER

- 1. Call the number shown below, but not before July 1
- 2. You will be asked to provide your phone number and if that is the number you are calling about. Say "Yes" or "No", whichever is the case. If "No" you will be asked for the phone number associated with your account.
- 3. You will be asked "What are you calling about?" . Say "Billing"
- 4. When you reach the billing department, ask for "Bulk Billing"
- 5. When you reach Bulk Billing, you will be asked, again, for your phone number and address and all the details of your account will be shown to the agent. Request Bulk Billing for your internet and cable service. It's possible that your phone service is still assigned to Brighthouse, so be certain to request that the phone be put on Spectrum.

 Otherwise you will pay \$45/month for that phone service. (Instead of \$19.95) The agent will also go over the other services you are using and verify which ones you wish to keep.
- 6. You are eligible to receive additional converter boxes as follows: If you have one box currently, you are eligible for one additional box; if you only have a DVR/converter or no converter boxes you are eligible for two; if you already have two converter boxes you are not eligible to receive any. If you do not currently have a modem, you are eligible to receive one. You can pick your additional equipment up at Spectrum's location at 1176 East Bay Drive or have it delivered to you for a charge of \$49.99.
- 7. There is no time limit as to when you must make the transition. However you will continue to receive a bill from Spectrum for the retail price of cable and Internet, as well previously announced addition to your monthly Rent/maintenance fee (as of September 1), until you make the transition. There will be no charge from the Co-Op in July and August.

IF YOU ARE NOT CURRENTLY A SPECTRUM CUSTOMER

All residents of Paradise Island will become a part of this new system. Your monthly rent or maintenance fee will be increased by \$30 to pay for Internet and cable TV. We hope that by your inclusion in this project, you will enjoy the TV and Internet service you are not currently taking advantage of.

1. Call the number shown above, but not before July 1.



- 2. When you are asked what you are calling about, say "Sales", then- "Set up a new account."
- 3. The agent will ask for your address, and that information will indicate what services you are eligible for.
- 4. Your previously announced monthly fee provides the Internet and Cable services. There are other services, such as phone, available to you at additional cost. You are also eligible to receive two cable converter boxes and one Internet modem. You should request both.
- 5. We recommend that you use Spectrum to deliver and install your new equipment. The charge for this service is \$49.99 for the converter boxes and a \$34.99 charge to install the modem. There are individuals in the community that can install both items at a much lower cost, but you will have to pick the equipment up at 1176 East Bay Drive. Contact the office for more information.

reetings neighbors! Spectrum is live and for the most part the transition went surprisingly very well. There were minor bumps in the road with pricing issues. If you feel you are being charged more than your neighbor for the same extra channel or piece of equipment, do not hesitate to call Spectrum back. Make certain to determine you are speaking with a Bulk Billing Specialist. Enjoy the summer of free TV and internet. On September 1, your payments to the Co Op will begin.

I would like to thank my colleges from the Co Op President Keith Knowles, Vice President Pat Humphries, Treasurer Janyce Cruse for inviting me, Art Yeo, and Ruth Charron to work on the committee to negotiate this contract for our residents. We spent what seemed like an eternity in the research and negotiation of this contract. We have proven that when the Co Op and The HOA work together for the residents of this community anything is possible.

We have been receiving many complaints from our out of town neighbors about cars and trucks being parked in their driveways when they are not here. No one has the right to park their vehicle in an empty carport if it is not yours, unless you have the expressed permission of that owner. If you are caught parked without permission of the owners the vehicle will be towed at your expense and a violation letter will be issued.

Make sure your hurricane emergency kits are ready and you have your plans in place in the event one decides to visit our area. Pay close attention to the news and be prepared to evacuate. Remember, if we are issued a mandatory evacuation order YOU MUST LEAVE or you may DIE. It is also against the law to stay in your home. Be smart and do not take the chance to wait it out.




