Information for all residents

When you are hiring someone to do work at your home or trim your trees it is very important that you check them for their insurance and license. Your insurance company may not pay for damages if an unlicensed person has done the repair. This includes your roof. Materials that a licensed roofer uses will pass inspection but the unlicensed roofer will not. Remember that a handy man is just that and you need to check that they are qualified to do the work. Also remember that the top amount for any job done by a handyman is limited to \$500.00 for any job.

This is the time when storms and mosquitos are a large problem. If you see standing water, you need to empty containers to reduce the breeding of mosquitos. With hurricane season in full swing make sure all small objects, that could become flying objects, should be placed in storage for the storm season. Inspection of the ponds is complete and the inspection showed that the ponds are free of mosquitos at this time.

If there is a hurricane and the Governor states "Mandatory Evacuation" of Mobile Homes we are required to leave. If you do not leave the home and you need help after the notice is given there is no one that will be able to come to help you. We want you safe and able to return home. Please, take the notice and leave when they call for evacuation, do not wait until it is too late. If you have to leave due to a hurricane take a little time to turn off the water to the home and power to the home. The storms move fast and you should be home soon after the storm departs.

The Clubhouse is not a shelter and will be locked during the storm and not reopened until it is safe to have residents in. Based on last year, it did not take long. As soon as possible we will have things running again.

Spectrum Last Channel Access

s Spectrum pushes out changes or updates to our boxes, they are setting the 'Default Channel' to 1998 INFO where the lady is selling and promoting Spectrum.

To reset the Spectrum channel back to the last channel watched, do the following: Near the top center of the controller is the OK/SEL button with four curved buttons around

it. These will be the primary buttons to press in this procedure.

- On the left side of the curved buttons, Press Settings button once
- Pressing the right hand curved button, scroll over to the word Display so it is highlighted in Blue.
- Use a curved button to either scroll up or down to highlight the words 'Power on Channel' and press the 'OK/SEL' button
- Find 'Last Channel' and scroll to highlight it in Blue.
- Press OK/SEL to place a white dot before the words.
- Press the 'Settings' button again to Exit to the TV screen
- Select a channel of choice.

When you power off the box and then power it on, the TV will come on to the Last Channel viewed.


