


Bright House & Channel 96

If you have Bright House cable for your TV and were able to receive Channel 96 but now you cannot because you had a new cable box installed recently, the reason is the Converter that sends the Channel 96 power point presentation from the clubhouse goes through an Analog conversion box but your new box in the home is a Digital box. The solution to receive channel 96 again is to do the following:

Call Bright House at 727-324-1009 and get to technical support for Cable TV. Tell them you have had a new box installed but now channel 96 is not available. Tell them they need to come out to your home and if your TV is connected to an 'HDMI' box, they



need to install a 'cable splitter' on the input line and connect a lead to the BH box and another to the TV's cable input.

Once your TV set is connected by a Cable input, you will NEED the TV controller, Turn on the TV with the TV controller then on the controller, find and press 'Input' or 'Source' to get the available selections of 'TV', 'AV', 'Component2', 'HDMI1', and 'HDMI2'. It will be set to one of the 'HDMI' settings. Using the arrow keys (with OK or ENTER on the center button), either scroll up or down to select 'TV'. Press the center OK button. Then tune the TV to 96. When you finish watching 96, reverse the above process to get back to 'Normal' channels.

Wednesday Craft Club



SCAMMERS on the Internet

Tithin the last few months I received at least four fraudulent contacts claiming to be from financial institutions. Two had the recognizable logo of Wells Fargo, with whom I bank; and two from other financial institutions. Each said that there had been multiple attempts to access my account which may have been fraudulent, please sign on with my correct name and password. I did not do so, but contacted the bank, got the toll free number of their fraud department and forwarded the e-mails to them for their action. Needless to say, I did not respond to the others. I just want folks to be aware that this is happening.

Many times I get e-mails from legitimate contacts that say something like; Hey, thought you'd be interested in this... then show a link. NEVER CLICK ON ONE OF THOSE LINKS! These are phishing scams. If you click on the link they will infect your computer and access everyone on your mailing list. Just be aware and protect yourself, your data, and your finances.

These scammers also call by phone. They claim to be from Microsoft, Dell or other computer related companies. They say that your computer is in danger and you must turn control of your computer over to them immediately or it will crash. NEVER ALLOW THEM TO TAKE OVER YOUR COMPUTER. These companies do not make unsolicited calls, those making the calls are also phishing scammers.




