## Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

### SCAMS AND FRAUDS from Largo Police Bulletin

### Outstanding Warrant Fraud Friday, February 3, 2017 10:51pm

Pinellas County residents were warned to be on the alert to a recent phone scam in which a man is pretending to be a lieutenant with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office to steal money, according to the Sheriff's Office.

Detectives said the man calls residents and identifies himself as Lt. Thomas Jackson, before telling the resident they have an outstanding warrant from missing jury duty. The man then instructs the citizen to go to a convenience store and purchase gift cards in increments of \$500 and provide the numbers of the back of the gift card, the Sheriff's Office said. The man claims the warrant will be gone once the money is paid for the card. Detectives said the scam has targeted multiple residents in Pinellas County so far. The Sheriff's Office said it would never request money over the phone and urged people to report suspicious activity.

Anyone who has information about this scam or knows someone has been victimized is asked to call the Sheriff's Office at (727) 582-6200.

### Beware of the "Can You Hear Me?" Scam February 15, 2017

• Pinellas County Consumer Protection is alerting residents of new

robocall scam • If you receive a phone call asking "Can You Hear Me?" – hang up; do not say yes • Residents advised to not answer calls from unfamiliar numbers.

The latest scam may sound like a commercial, but it's not. Pinellas County Consumer Protection is advising residents who receive a phone call asking "Can you hear me?" to hang up and not say yes. The objective is to get the victim to respond to the question by saying "yes". That affirmative response is recorded and then used to authorize unwanted charges on a phone bill, utility bill or with a stolen credit card.

To add legitimacy to the transaction, the scammer may have already collected some personal information about the victim. When the victim disputes the charge, the scammer will validate the charge with the recording of the victim saying "yes," therefore approving the charge. Remember: the question doesn't have to be "Can you hear me?" It can be any question that prompts a "yes" response. The best way to prevent becoming a victim of a telephone scam is to not answer calls from unfamiliar numbers. Residents are advised to hang up if they answer the call.

If you suspect you are a victim of this scam, here are some steps to take:

• Check your credit card, phone or cable statements for unauthorized charges. • Dispute the unauthorized charges with your billing company. • If you have been told that you have been reported as approving the charge(s), request proof.






