#### **ABOUT THE NON-POTABLE WATER**

People with sensitive shrubbery and new sod have been particularly affected. The first thing we have to understand (and accept!) is that our park's infrastructure is 30 years old and breakdowns in the system are to be expected. For example, the last two shut downs were due to the failure of rubber seals where two 8" pipes are joined. The failures took place in different areas of the park, but still resulted in the shutdown of the entire system in order to repair the leak.

Because the problems were with the main 8" pipes, repair was beyond the scope of a traditional plumber and a company skilled in that type of repair had to be brought in. The first thing that must be done is to dig down at least four feet to expose the pipe. The hole must be large enough to accommodate the workers, so it usually has to be about 6 foot wide. Because all the pipes for water, sewer and non-potable are in the same area, the holes have to be dug by hand. Just the digging of the hole will consume 3-4 days. Once the pipe is exposed, the easy part, repairing the leak, can be done in a matter of hours.

We can count on similar failures of the non-potable system in the future. However, please be assured that we will act as promptly as possible to repair these breakdowns. More importantly, I ask for patience when dealing with the office staff, who are only reporting what they are told by the contractor.




