They also distributed free nightlights and most importantly, magnetic pockets that you put on your refrigerator. Emergency personnel are trained to look for these. The form inside list all your medical information including a list of all your medications and emergency contact numbers. In addition, we became aware that when the smoke alarm goes on, we have 2 minutes to get out.

We cannot stress enough the importance of attending these presentations, it may save your life.

VETERAN'S CORNER

- 2. The Departments of Veterans Affairs, Defense and Homeland Security have been working together for months on plans for how the program will be implemented. A crucial part of that is the credential required to get onto the base and to shop at the stores, because most veterans who aren't retired don't have access to installations. Defense officials are working to enable technology at the front gate to scan those veteran cards so veterans can get in to use those benefits. Commissary officials are working on adjusting their technology to enable systems to read the cards.
- 3. "The Veteran Health Identification Card, (VHIC), is the only credential that DoD resale and MWR facilities will accept from veterans authorized privileges solely under the Purple Heart and Disabled Veterans Equal Access Act of 2018," said DoD spokeswoman Jessica Maxwell. "Specific questions about who can and how to obtain a VHIC should be directed to the Department of Veterans Affairs." For their part, VA officials say DoD is in charge of this benefit expansion. "We are working with DoD to accommodate all eligible veterans," said VA spokesman Randy Noller.
- 4. For veteran caregivers who are newly eligible, the process will be different, initially, since caregivers aren't directly affiliated with DoD or VA, other than through the annual appointment to be a caregiver. The benefit applies to the primary caregiver of wounded/injured veterans who are registered in the VA caregiver program. The VA will post a memo to VA.gov for caregivers, to be used for access at the front gate, along with driver's license or other authorized form of ID. The VA process will later transition to a caregiver-type ID card, which will have scanning swipe capability.
- 5. Another important piece of information if you go to MacDill AFB to get your prescriptions the Pharmacare building is now closed. You have to go to the main clinic to put in a new script, expect a wait. You also cannot pick them up on the same day, you have to come back and get them at the Pharmacare drive thru. If you just have a refill you can still call them in and pick them up at the drive-thru, again expect a delay because everyone is now picking up their scripts there and they are no longer open on Saturdays! You can also expect an increase of prices in the tiers for Preferred Scripts, the mail order pharmacy!
- 6. Important Dates
 - 1 OCT 2019 All VA Property has gone smoke free.
 - Any individuals that have Federal Vision or Dental Plans the open season is November 11, though Dec 9, 2019. There are increases in prices so get on the site and shop and compare.

3 Billion Birds

By Pam Stover

recently published study in the journal Science has revealed shocking declines in bird populations across North America. Since 1970, we have lost 2.9 billion birds. That Inumber translates to nearly 1 in 3 birds that have been lost. Surprisingly, some of the species that have experienced the greatest declines are some of the most common. Over the last 50 years, we have lost enormous numbers of familiar birds. The loss of these wonderful animals is devastating in and of itself, but it is also a sign of much larger problems. Birds are excellent indicator species – they are sensitive to changes in their environments and we have abundant data on birds from both professional researchers and citizen scientists. When we know birds are in trouble, we can infer that the ecosystems to which they are intricately linked are also in trouble. Many of the factors that we know are causing bird population declines – climate change, habitat loss, pressure from invasive species and pesticide use – also affect countless other species of plants and animals. There are 7 simple steps you can easily take to make a difference, many of which already will be familiar to our readers. Preventing window strikes, landscaping with native plants, keeping cats indoors, avoiding pesticide use, drinking bird-friendly coffee, reducing plastic use and participating in citizen science initiatives are all actions you can take to protect bird species today. Another important step? Make sure that you are a voice for birds. Share this news with friends and family on social media or by word of mouth!


