SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CONTRACTORS By Keith Knowles

The first and most important fact that most people are not aware of is that it is the homeowner's responsibility to be sure that they only hire contractors that are licensed and insured. This fact is important for several reasons:

- The County holds the homeowner legally responsible if they hire an uninsured and unlicensed contractor.
- The homeowner is responsible for any damage to their home or the property of others caused by an uninsured contractor.
- If any uninsured contractor gets injured while working for the homeowner the homeowner will be responsible for their medical bills.
- Never hire a contractor that is unlicensed and uninsured.

All work done by contractors has be done only Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 am and 5 pm. Inside work can be done at other times as long as it does not create a disturbance.

Remodeling or construction material waste should be removed either by the contractor performing the work or by the homeowner. Maintenance staff will reject large pieces of furniture, rugs, or appliances, etc. set out for removal. Residents must then make other arrangements to remove these materials from the community.

There are individuals in the park with police records that are providing services to our residents. Despite our best efforts, we have been unable to remove these individuals from the community. You can help do that by asking any individual seeking to work for you if they have a police record and if you are uncertain of their answer check the police department yourself or call the office for information.

If someone comes to your door seeking to do work for you, send them away. This action is in your best interest for two reasons: First, there is no soliciting allowed in Paradise Island; second and most important: THEY WILL CHEAT YOU!

This year she fed 8550 families a Thanksgiving dinner. So once again a sincere thank you to all those that helped with their donations.

Paradise Island Outreach Fund

Thave found that there are a number of our residents who do not even know that we have this fund or they have no true idea of what and how it works. I pray that I can explain in enough detail here to educate every resident of Paradise Island about the care we have for our own. I must first assure everyone that this is the "Paradise Island Outreach Fund!" Not the Para-

dise Island Church in the Park Outreach, or the church Outreach fund. It is its own entity. The Paradise Island Outreach Fund stands alone. The fund IS administered by the Church in the Park. There are several reasons for this, the chief being that it is covered under the church's Non-Profit status. Financially they are totally separate. Each has its own banking account, accounting and disclosure requirements. The "Funds" and the "Church's" moneys cannot and do not inter-mingle. Neither one can be used for the other with the one exception that the "Church" pays one half of its tithe to the "Fund". I cannot over emphasize that the "funds" money has nothing to do with the church! When you give to the Paradise Island Outreach Fund, 100% of that gift is used for the residents of your community, "Paradise Island." The "Fund" has no fees, compensation, or bills other than you, as a resident, needs. This is the only benevolence fund that I know of that 100% is returned to those to whom it is intended. Yes we use Godly principles in order to be good stewards of your money. But to my knowledge there has never been any discrimination due to race, color, creed, religion, or anything I can think of. We do investigate each need on an individual basis and our giving is to meet what we believe to be a true need. We DO NOT deal with cash! All gifts have a paper trail, i.e. a check to Duke Energy, etc. However, we can issue food gift cards and are considering gas gift cards as well. These are tracked by name and lot #. All information about the dealings between the administrators and those in need are covered under the ministerial confidentially principle. I will not even disclose too you who gave me your name or lot # without the express permission of the giver. I hold this confidentially responsibility very dear and consider it a great privilege to be allowed to hold this position. Therefore, any conversation, donation, receiving of a gift, or any matter you deal with

PET CRISIS: Are you prepared to handle one?

In a community like Paradise Island, where a large number of residents have pets, predominantly cats and dogs, there are bound to be incidents of a critical nature that call for the taking of immediate action. In the event of the ingestion, inhalation, or absorption of a poisonous substance; or of anything that is alarming enough for the need to act, this article will provide you with the steps to follow.

Since most residents are of the age that necessitates the use of a variety of medications, it is a safe bet that on occasion one or more pills are accidentally dropped on the floor. If "Fido" or "Misty" are typical, they are more likely to find the dropping before you do. This becomes your "OH! OH!" moment. The immediate action you take could be the difference between the life or death of your pet. Will you be ready to do the right thing?

Because I'm very familiar with such an encounter, I want to offer a few steps to be taken immediately in an effort to avoid an unnecessary death or serious illness. Please keep the following information handy if and when such action is required by you.

- 1. Determine the toxin, pill, or substance your pet has ingested. Don't guess!
- 2. Call your veterinarian (Vet) immediately with the vital information.
- 3. If the Vet is unavailable for any reason, Call the Pet Poison hotline at 1-855-764-7661. Note: There may be a small charge for the advice but it will be worth it. They will do the research to determine the seriousness of the ingestion, offer you a case number, and provide you with the name and phone number of the nearest clinic; then will call ahead to speak with the clinicians about your specific problem, including case number, in advance of your arrival in order to determine the proper procedure(s) to implement.
- 4. Provide, if possible, as much information, including the actual name(s) of the drug; the observed signs by you such as color of gums, respiratory rate, temperature, etc.
- 5. If the Pet Poison hotline, upon evaluation of the drug, determines that emergency care is needed, you will be directed to the nearest emergency veterinary clinic. (The closest one to Paradise Island is Emergency Care Center, 1501 Belcher Road, between East Bay and Ulmerton.) Their telephone number is 727-531-5752.









- 6. If so inclined, you can go directly to the Emergency Care Center. It's your choice.
- 7. If you have any doubt at all, act prudently by taking this advice.

Due to the anxiety caused by the experience (and with no previous knowledge of the information provided here), my wife, Cheryl, acted instinctively and did exactly as I am recommending. Because of it, the pet in question, though in a serious state, spent the night at the clinic, was carefully monitored and received care for 24-hours. In this case, the pet, a dog, swallowed a half pill but it was determined to be powerful enough to take the pet's life if ignored. Fortunately, Cheryl's immediate action saved his life.

As pet owners and animal lovers, we want to be sure to avoid an unnecessary death or prolonged illness. Some of you might decide to take matters into your own hands but if there is a shadow of a doubt be sure to do the right thing by getting veterinary assistance. Please keep in mind the fact that your pet can't fend for itself. You are the caretaker and guardian of her or him. Act accordingly so the crisis can come to a happy ending.
