



We also need to certify another Kitchen Manager as a backup for Frank. If you are interested in cooking and managing the Kitchen during special events call me and I will explain what this entails.


Our meetings are the first Wednesday of each month. We have coffee and donuts between 6-7PM. We start our meetings promptly at 7PM.

## **Invasion of the space worms**

ong-term space travel poses many challenges, but one of the most daunting is the loss of muscle mass in a zero-gravity environment. On a voyage to Mars, for example, space travelers could arrive on the red planet too weak to stand. 
