ROAD PAVEMENT PROJECT

The Paradise Island Road Pavement Project will conclude with the paving of Phase Two, scheduled to start in early January 2015 (see map). The contractor will grind and remove the existing road surface, prepare the roadbed, and then lay new pavement. This big project will disrupt many of us in the park. We will experience noise, dust, and inconvenience, for which we apologize in advance. No street parking will be allowed in the project area. Residents directly affected by the project will get a flyer at their homes with up-to-date schedules and news.

Vehicles can ride on the new pavement in a straight line soon

after the new pavement is laid; however, the contractor tells us that making turns, into and out of driveways for example, will not be possible for a full day. Emergency services: fire, police, etc. will be notified (of course, we will not deny them access anywhere) and the issue of mail delivery is under discussion. to provide the level of service that you now receive.



possible as Russ Ward lot #173 cut all the molding for this project. THANK YOU





SCAMMERS claiming to be IRS

Recently our resident have received calls from scammers claiming to be from the IRS. The following is from the IRS website:

"Victims are told they owe money to the IRS and it must be paid promptly through a pre-loaded debit card or wire transfer. If the victim refuses to cooperate, they are then threatened with arrest, deportation or suspension of a business or driver's license. In many cases, the caller becomes hostile and insulting."

If someone unexpectedly calls claiming to be from the IRS and threatens police arrest, deportation or license revocation if you don't pay immediately, that is a sign that it really isn't the IRS calling." The first IRS contact with taxpayers on a tax issue is likely to occur via mail

Other characteristics of this scam include:

- Scammers use fake names and IRS badge numbers. They generally use common names and surnames to identify themselves.
- Scammers may be able to recite the last four digits of a victim's Social Security Number.
- Scammers spoof the IRS toll-free number on caller ID to make it appear that it's the IRS calling.

- Scammers sometimes send bogus IRS emails to some victims to support their bogus calls.
- Victims hear background noise of other calls being conducted to mimic a call site.
- After threatening victims with jail time or driver's license revocation, scammers hang up and others soon call back pretending to be from the local police or DMV, and the caller ID supports their claim.
- If you get a phone call from someone claiming to be from the IRS, here's what you should do:
- If you know you owe taxes or you think you might owe taxes, call the IRS at 1.800.829.1040. The IRS employees at that line can help you with a payment issue if there really is such an issue.
- If you know you don't owe taxes or have no reason to think that you owe any taxes (for example, you've never received a bill or the caller made some bogus threats as described above), then call and report the incident to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration at 1.800.366.4484.
- You can file a complaint using the FTC Complaint Assistant; choose "Other" and then "Imposter Scams." If the complaint involves someone impersonating the IRS, include the words "IRS Telephone Scam" in the notes.

Taxpayers should be aware that there are other unrelated scams (such as a lottery sweep-stakes) and solicitations (such as debt relief) that fraudulently claim to be from the IRS.


