### **WE NEED YOUR HELP!**

Park management is diligent in enforcing the rules of the community when violations are brought to their attention either directly or indirectly. However, in the case of overweight dogs and loud motorcycles, it is difficult for management to identify the violations. That's where you come in. If you are aware of an overweight dog (over 40 lbs.) or a loud motorcycle (see rule below), please call the office at 535-2172 and let Nancy know the lot number of the violation. Your information is considered strictly confidential. While this may seem a little 1984-ish it's one way we can continue to keep our community in top shape and protect everyone's property values. Here's the rule on motorcycles, adopted in June of 2013.

Any vehicle that exceeds a decibel level of 75db (while operated normally at the park's speed limit or below) will be required to meet this standard. No vehicle may be operated in the community that has a modified or removed muffler system. All residents are responsible for the compliance of their guest and/or renters in this regard. (We have the equipment to measure the 75 decibel sound level.)




