### Time to Prepare for Storm Season Begins June 30 until November 30 Lessons learned from Irma

If we are told that we have to evacuate, we MUST GO, we cannot stay for any reason.

- 1. Let your family know where you are going.
- 2. Do not return to your home unless there is power.
- 3. Call the management office to ask if it is safe to return to the park. (727-535-2172). During Irma, family members were calling the office trying to locate you, if you do not advise the management office where you are you may be creating unnecessary fear.
- 4. If you chose to go to a shelter, do not leave until you are told that your home is
- 5. safe and it is OK to do so. Once you leave you cannot return. Make sure you bring a blanket, a pillow, toiletries, towels and washcloths, change of clothes for 7 days with you to the shelter and whatever food/drinks you want. During Irma the shelters were running very low on food and drinks.
- NOW is the time to pre-register for assistance if: a) you have no transportation b) have medical needs or c) have special needs.

  - or call Pinellas County Emergency Management at 727-464-3800 Florida County Animal Services: 727-582-2600
- ➤ Should have food and water to last each person for at least 3 days. In Pinellas County, it is a good idea to plan for up to 10 days of food and water per person in case the county would be cut off from the mainland for some time.
- ➤ Have all your needs on hand: fill your prescriptions, radios, batteries, phone chargers, flashlights and first-aid kits. Battery operated radio or weather Alert Radio and battery operated fans these can be purchased at Walmart or Amazon are also good ideas.
  - Gas up your vehicle.
  - Make sure you have extra cash on hand. ATM machines might be out of order.

Put everything in a box - all your important documents in a waterproof pouch (ex: extra-large zip lock bags) and keep them in a safe place. If you evacuate take them with you. Ex: car and mobile home insurance info. / car and home titles / passports / a copy of your medication list and medical condition you are being treated for, etc.

### **Preparing to leave:**

Bring in all outside items (grills, planters, lawn objects, furniture, etc.) Clean out your refrigerator/freezer. Shut OFF water and electrical breakers in your panel box.

REMINDER: For our enjoyment, Bingo and the Kitchen continue to be opened every Thursday throughout the summer.

4th of July – In lieu of the Men's Club 4th of July bash, the HOA will have bingo.

WARNING: Never open your doors to a stranger If someone knocks at your door who is familiar to you asking to borrow money, do not get taken you will never see your money again. They lie, say anything to get you to give them money, just call the police.

Another safety tip: In order to be ready to dial 9ll spontaneously, on your phone before going to bed dial 911 but do not push the dial icon. If you should need it, all you have to do is push one key. Keep your phone on your night table. You may want also to leave your car keys on your nightstand, if you hit the red alarm button, it will make enough noise to attract the neighbors' attention until the police arrive or scare someone away.

For new residents in our community, a good way to meet your neighbors is to attend the monthly pool party or try your luck at bingo.

The HOA Board of Directors is on a well-deserved adjournment. However, we are available to any HOA member if the need arises. The next membership meeting will be on Wednesday, September 4th.




