## Meow Now Managing and Ending Overpopulation Wisely of Feral Cats

Pinellas County has a HUGE Community (previously known as feral) cat overpopulation problem and Paradise Island is no exception. The county has learned that removing community cats does not work new colonies of cats just move in. So what is the answer?????

Meow Now is offering a TNVR (Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-return) Program. Meow Now traps the cats, transports them to be neutered/spayed, vaccinated for both rabies and distemper, and then releases the cats back into their previous habitat. The cats will also have their left ear tipped for easy recognition.

This program is FREE but does rely donations; Paradise Island HOA has volunteered to cover the donation.

### SO HOW CAN RESIDENTS HELP??

1. Place LOT NUMBERS where cats are seen in the Neighborhood Watch Bin located in the Club House

- 2. Do not FEED the cats 24 hours before trap dates: June 13 and June 14
- 3. Make sure personal cats remain inside to avoid being trapped HOW CAN RESIDENTS VOLUNTEER??
- 1. Donate old sheets/towels to place over traps to calm cats
- 2. Donate tuna fish or cans of cat food to bait traps

## Is Speed the Issue in Paradise Island?

## speed limit 15

T seems as though the discussion about drivers exceeding the speed limit on the streets of Paradise Island has reached a point of silliness. Unless you are confined to the park, where all you have to do with your time is measure the speed of vehicles, there is a whole other world of "speed" outside our gates.

Let's be honest here. The speed limit of 15mph is extremely low. We don't live in a school zone, nor do we have funeral processions traversing our streets. We are an adult community wherein each of us must act responsibly when driving a vehicle. To exceed the limit by a few miles per hour should not be

grounds for speed bumps, blinking lights — or speed notifiers. Most, and I mean most, resident drivers are responsible and considerate when driving in the park. As a resident for 14 years, I can count on one hand the number of resident speeders I have personally witnessed. I, for one, have found myself going a little too fast at times. When I realize it, I correct it.

Throughout any day, the traffic within our park consists of vendors from all types of businesses, taxis, ambulances, delivery trucks, moving vans, visitors, bingo players, and many more. Most of them have never driven at a speed of 15mph. They tend to drive at a higher speed, yet they, too, act responsibly when they are reminded of the speed limits.

We are a senior community. We don't have children running about. Why, then are we so concerned about drivers exceeding 15mph? However, there is a concern for people walking up and down the middle of streets; bicyclists that ignore stop signs; or golf carts and bicycles that have no lighting or reflectors. These issues could and should be discussed.



Let's not become a community of complainers. Our society, at large, finds plenty to whine about without our family friendly park getting bogged down in trivial matters. It's one thing to witness the nonsense surrounding the NFL with deflagategate and the psi's of a football. This witch hunt has taken the air out of the NFL. We don't need a speedgate to deflate the value of our beautiful community.

It is simple enough. DRIVE WITH CARE AND CONSIDERATION.



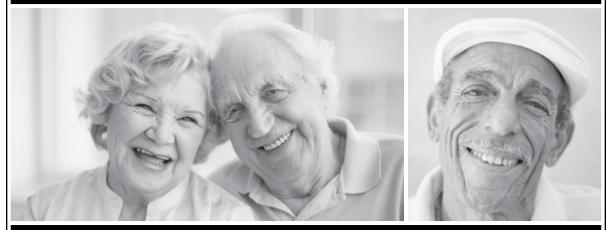

## Where there's a will, you need a plan

t sounds like the setup for a joke: A rich uncle dies and leaves you a fortune. But what happens next in real life? A financial windfall, large or small, needs to be managed well. Here are some tips on what to do if you come into some money:

## Fly Old Glory with pride on Flag Day

F lag Day became an official national celebration in 1916, when President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed June 14 Flag Day to commemorate the adoption of the Stars and Stripes by the Second Continental Congress on that day in 1777.

The idea of setting aside a special day to celebrate the U.S. flag wasn't new, though. One of the earliest observances of Flag Day occurred in Hartford, Conn., in 1861, at the suggestion of George Morris, to pray for the preservation of the Union at the beginning of the Civil War.

In 1885, a Wisconsin schoolteacher named Bernard J. Cigrand held a formal observance of what he called "Flag Birthday" at his school. Cigrand went on to become a passionate promoter of Flag Day, delivering more than 2,000 speeches on the subject, and he is generally considered to be the "Father of Flag Day."

In 1914, Secretary of the Interior Franklin K. Lane delivered a Flag Day speech in which he said the flag had spoken to him that morning: "I am what you make me; nothing more. I swing before your eyes as a bright gleam of color, a symbol of yourself." In 1949, President Harry Truman signed an Act of Congress formally establishing June 14 as National Flag Day.




