SCAMS AND FRAUDS

From Largo Police Crime Bulletin

#1 – Credit Card Interest Scam

Everyone wants to save money, and to think that they are making smart choices with their finances. So when an individual calls you to offer you a lower interest rate on your credit card, you're bound to take it seriously. Unfortunately, once a scammer has your interest, you're more like to fall for fraud. In a recent scam report to the BBB, the caller—who claimed to be from the would-be victim's credit card company—stated that he was eligible for a lower interest rate. All he would need to do in order to process the better rate would be to verify all of his information, including account number and Social Security number. Fortunately, the recipient doesn't have a credit card with that company, but even more importantly, he smelled a scam and refused to turn over his data. It's important to remember that no one who calls you will ever need all of your information, and that anyone who contacts you and asks for sensitive information like your Social Security number is not to be trust-ed.

#2 – Government Grant

Just in a matter of a few days, multiple reports were made to the BBB about government grant scams. Callers who identify themselves as working for the US government to distribute free grant money are really just looking for your personal identifying information and account information in order to steal your identity and your money. While it's true that a lot of grant and scholarship money goes unclaimed every year, there's a basic reason for that: because the process of applying for those funds is very involved. The government simply does not call random citizens and offer them money. No one does, and if you're ever offered money or gifts in exchange for your information or a small application fee, hang up immediately.

#3 – Debt Collection Scam

This is a strange variation on an old scam, and it's alarming because it's far too easy for it to work. In this in-stance, a caller contacted the victim about a current debt. The caller claimed to work for a payment processing center, and stated that the debt had been sent to this company in order to work with the victim on making payments. It sounded a lot like a collections company, but somewhat friendlier. The victim agreed to make payments since he did, in fact, owe the debt. Unfortunately, the company wasn't real, and the debt wasn't actually paid off. The victim paid the full amount of the debt (broken up into two payments), but now he still owes that amount to the original debtor. Remember, you will never have to make payment in any way to someone who calls you over the phone or emails you. You may be sent reminder notices or receive reminder phone calls, but all legitimate payments will be initiated via a paper bill; follow up messages are fine, only after the original debt has been stated in writing with complete company information and account numbers. If you're contacted and told to make a payment immediately, request a letter in writing and then verify it before ever sending a dime.

Paradise Island Outreach Fund

have found that there are a number of our residents who do not even know that we have this fund or they have no true idea of what and how it works. I pray that I can explain in enough Letail here to educate every resident of Paradise Island about the care we have for our own. I must first assure everyone that this is the "Paradise Island Outreach Fund!" Not the Paradise Island Church in the Park Outreach, or the church Outreach fund. It is its own entity. The Paradise Island Outreach Fund stands alone. The fund IS administered by the Church in the Park. There are several reasons for this, the chief being that it is covered under the church's Non-Profit status. Financially they are totally separate. Each has its own banking account, accounting and disclosure requirements. The "Funds" and the "Church's" moneys cannot and do not inter-mingle. Neither one can be used for the other with the one exception that the "Church" pays one half of its tithe to the "Fund". I cannot over emphasize that the "funds" money has nothing to do with the church! When you give to the Paradise Island Outreach Fund, 100% of that gift is used for the residents of your community, "Paradise Island." The "Fund" has no fees, compensation, or bills other than you, as a resident, needs. This is the only benevolence fund that I know of that 100% is returned to those to whom it is intended. Yes we use Godly principles in order to be good stewards of your money. But to my knowledge there has never been any discrimination due to race, color, creed, religion, or anything I can think of. We do investigate each need on an individual basis and our giving is to meet what we believe to be a true need. We DO NOT deal with cash! All gifts have a paper trail, i.e. a check to Duke Energy, etc. However, we can issue food gift cards and are considering gas gift cards as well. These are tracked by name and lot #. All information about the dealings between the administrators and those in need are covered under the ministerial confidentially principle. I will not even disclose too you who gave me your name or lot # without the express permission of the giver. I hold this confidentially responsibility very dear and consider it a great privilege to be allowed to hold this position. Therefore, any conversation, donation, receiving of a gift, or any matter you deal with me and the fund is between God, you and me period. All donations will be greatly appreciated by someone in this park. Donations can be given in any form to me or any member of the Church in the Park. Please designate all gifts to the Outreach Fund. Every single aluminum can you put in one of our containers helps someone here in the park. An accident is looking for a place to happen

recent phone call reported to me that while driving in the dark of night, especially between 4:30am and daylight, it is commonplace to see golf carts being driven around Paradise Island with no headlights, taillights, or brake lights; and bicyclists ignoring stop signs and rounding corners with no form of lighting or reflectors. In the same early hours, the newspaper delivery vehicles are whizzing through the park to deliver their papers to their customers by throwing the papers out the window without as much as slowing down. It is neither safe nor wise for those involved because eventually a serious accident or fatality will happen.

It has been a topic of conversation among some in the park in the past but since there is nothing in the Paradise Island Rules and Regulations mandating requiring golf cart headlights, taillights; or bicycle lighting and/or reflectors, there is little that can be done about it. One resident told me of a close call with a bicyclist who came around a corner without slowing down. Another reported being taken by surprise as a golf cart with no lights came along as he was backing out of his driveway.

Basically, adding the proper lighting and reflectors is the responsible thing to do because it is in the best interest of the community at large. It's a small investment to to make when compared to the cost associated with the cost related to injury or death, especially within the confines of the park. The result will be an insurance nightmare. Golf carts, in the first place, are not built for night time driving since golf isn't played in the dark. Those built as residential vehicles generally come with proper lighting and mirrors. Bicycles, however, rarely come with lighting or reflectors, yet are very inexpensive.

The privilege afforded to residents of Paradise Island to use golf carts and bikes within its confines is a bonus. Certainly, it beats having to drive a personal vehicle to visit friends, go to clubhouse or pool, run up to the office, and/or simply ride through the park. But unlike the Pinellas Trail which is specific to bicycles, etc.; cars, trucks and recreational vehicles are driven through our park day and night so it's always best to be safe rather than sorry.

All too often we hear the phrase, "It can't or won't happen here." Well, it can and probably will unless the responsibility is taken seriously and proper steps are taken. We are fortunate to have a friendly and safe community. Let's all work together to keep it that way.












The winning argument?
