# **Matter of Balance Class**

There is a free Matter of Balance Class Mondays and Wednesdays from 2-4 pm at Largo City Hall 201 Highland Ave, Largo, FL . Classes start March 11th and end April 6th. Classes are March 11, 16, 18, 23, 25, 30 April 1 and April 6th.

Matter of Balance is a FREE evidence based, fall prevention program for seniors 60+ designed to reduce falls and increase activity levels. A workbook will be provided and it explores concerns and causes of falls and provides practical strategies on how to prevent falls. Starting at class 3, there will be 45 minutes of light, chair assisted exercises to increase balance and reduce falls. The class is limited to 12 people. New Rules and Regulations: In our February article, we mentioned that we were still waiting for a date from the Co-Op office for a Town Hall meeting. Although the Co-Op was planning a presentation to the residents of our community, they now feel there is no need to. The rules are self-explanatory. If you receive a letter of violation and you feel you were not at fault, you have to write a letter in response explaining why you have been unfairly accused. It will be investigated. Do not ignore it or call the management office. You must respond to the letter in writing. If it's not in writing they will not address it with their board.

It is our understanding that the Co-Op will be enforcing the rules and they will be towing your vehicle if you do not adhere to the rules and have a street parking permit.

Please pay special attention to:

Section XI /Vehicles & Traffic – Page 9 & 10 – Paragraphs 2, 5, 9 and 13

Safety tips:

- Scammers work overtime in planning their dishonest schemes. Be vigilant in all you do and remember to change your passwords on a regular basis.
- To avoid someone reading your credit cards with their special scanners, buy a "sleeve" to that effect. Place your card inside it (available at AAA and other places).
- Some fake scanners that look very real can be installed to read your card numbers. To be sure it is the real thing, shake the scanner, to confirm it is secure, especially at gas station but I do it everywhere (Walmart, etc.)

I had to change my debit card twice within the last few months. Someone was trying to charge my bank account. Not only was my bank hit but many banks in the neighborhood were hit as well.





## **Healthy Yards**

The drastic decrease of insects and pollinators should be a

concern for everyone. The good news is that our yards can help pollinators, and it's easy, all we have to do is.....less. Start with considering your lawn as an area rug, rather than a wall-to-wall carpet, with enough vegetative growth around it for animals and pollinators to shelter and nest. Don't clean all the dead branches and leaves. These provide valuable habitat for pollinators. And, most important, don't use toxins. Whatever sales literature tells you, there is NO "safe" pesticide that targets a single species. Also make sure the plants you purchase aren't treated with systemic pesticides. Plants, and plants from seeds, that are treated with systemic pesticides, like neonicotinoids, are highly toxic to insects, and remain so for many years.

Pesticide use is linked to canine and human cancers, hormone imbalances and neurological impairments. Yet, American homeowners purchase more than one billion pounds of pesticides and herbicides every year. This has caused our lawns to become the largest, most toxic, 'crop' in the USA.

Yes, grasses used for lawns might be smothered by excess leaves, but it's much better to mow right over the leaves and create mulch than to blow them away. Leaf mulch will settle into the grass, provide nutrients and reduce the need for fertilizers, weed killers and insecticides.

# **VETERAN'S CORNER**

lot of changes coming down the road in your health care both at the VA and for those of you that have Tricare for Life. I ask you all to pay attention to these changes and if they affect you let your politi-

cians know. Some of the proposed changes are cuts to medical billets and for those of you that use the base or an MTF cuts in the formularies used at the Pharmacy's. Some of the MTF's are even telling people over 65 to get their routine procedures done at regular hospitals.

There was no increase TRICARE for Life enrollment fees or deductibles in 2020. While Congress enacted no new programmed TRICARE, fee increases in the FY 2020 defense bill, several previously scheduled fee increases took effect Jan. 1:

- Enrollment fees for retirees who entered service prior to Jan. 1, 2018. TRICARE Prime: \$300 (single)/\$600 (family), up from \$297/\$594; TRICARE Select: No fee.
- Enrollment fees for retirees who entered service after Jan. 1, 2018. TRICARE Prime: \$366 (single)/\$732 (family), up from \$360/\$720; TRICARE Select: \$471 (single)/\$942 (family), up from \$462/\$924.
- Retail pharmacy fees. \$13 for 30-day supply of generic, \$33 for brand name, \$60 for nonformulary (up from \$11, \$28, and \$53, respectively).
- Mail-order pharmacy fees: \$10 for a 90-day supply of generic, \$29 for brand name, \$60 for non-formulary (up from \$7, \$24 and \$53, respectively).

Although, there are no fees for 30-90-day supplies for generic and brand-name drugs from military treatment facilities (MTFs). Non-formulary prescriptions are generally not available at MTFs. Anybody utilizing MacDill AFB now knows how difficult they are now making it to get your scripts. If you call the script in you can go to the window to get your refill as in the past. The big change is now you have to go to the Main Building and drop a new refill script off and then have to go back to the base the next day to pick it up at the drive thru where the lines are twice as long now. We have also found out without any advance warning that they are just routinely dropping what they use to cover. They have dropped my wife's Insulin, Nexium and Bystolic blood pressure medication. Since you cannot go until they are nearly out you have to scramble to either get them by Preferred Scripts (who have raised their prices) or at Walgreens. So, although there were no increases in Tricare for Life we are now paying out of pocket for these items. They also told us there will probably be more items dropped in the future. As I stated above If you have experienced any of these issues you should also be contacting your politicians to make them aware of them.



Although the Indiana Daily Student website reports Although the Indiana Daily Student website reports that only 3% of Americans identify as vegan, there's evidence that it's becoming more and more mainstream. A Harris Poll survey found that one in five Americans at least sometimes eat vegan when dining out, and data from Impossible Foods shows that more than 50% of millennials and Gen Z members eat



plant-based meat at least once a month, compared with one in five baby boomers.

Studies suggest that the slow rise of veganism is linked to concerns about the environment, a desire to address animal welfare, and overall health—although nutritionists point out that meatless burgers aren't necessarily healthier than beef because they include more salt and saturated fat.
