will all be so different we may not recognize one of our favorite holidays. Let's all be thankful. Let's stop all the ban tar and rumors and be grateful for the blessings we have enjoyed throughout the years.

As reported by the weather channel, this has been the year with the most hurricanes. Fortunately as of this date (October 15) Florida has been spared and the end of the season is on the horizon. We are hopeful it will continue for a little while longer.

The Paramedics were delayed getting to the critically ill resident. It could be a matter of life and death. A few years ago, both ends of the street were blocked and as a result a resident died. Next time this may be you. Before you park your car directly across from another car ask yourself can an emergency vehicle fit down the street? This rule was placed in the Paradise Island Co-Op Inc. Rules for a good reason. Besides not wanting to be issued a hefty fine from the Pinellas County Fire Marshal's Office, The Co-Op Board of Directors are concerned for all residents in the community. Please make sure you also inform your guests.

According to the scientists and doctors specializing in viruses, the second wave of Covid-19 is now starting all over and will especially be bad for Florida because of openings without restrictions all bars, restaurants, etc. Please protect yourselves and others by following the guidelines from the CDC.

Avoid all unnecessary exposure by getting food and water supply for 2 weeks. You can freeze almost anything. Keep in mind when freezing milk, it expands when it freezes so remove about ½ cup before freezing. Presently there are plenty of sanitizers, wipes, Lysol, etc. it is a good idea to get some more so we are not faced with empty shelves like we had in the spring. It is a good idea to have a 2 week supply in case we have to go to a shelter or cannot get out due to any health issues.

Stay busy, take a walk at the beach, visit county parks, botanical gardens, do projects that you have postponed all those years. The weather is cooling off now, we are lucky in Florida to have so many things we can do outside and observe a safe distance.

he Annual Craft Fair will be held Saturday November 7th, from 9 am to 2 pm at the PI Clubhouse. We are excited with all the returning vendors and new vendors. Over 40 vendors are eager to help you with your holiday shopping or just purchasing something new for your home.

**<u>EVERYONE</u>** will need to wear a mask entering the Clubhouse and while inside. Social distancing will be practiced much like when you are



## **WOOD STORK**

By Pam Stover

he only native stork in North America, the wood stork resides all over Florida, though is rare in the western Panhandle. Growing up to 3 ½-feet tall and with a 5-foot wingspan, it has white and black wings

and a bald head. It flies with its feet dangling behind. As a feeder in shallow ponds and swamps, this large bird uses tactolocation, sweeping its slightly opened bill back and forth to find prey in the water. Its diet includes fish, snakes, frogs, and snails. Storks love to glide to save energy, and a large group of them will find a warm updraft and form a "kettle." Circling to ever higher elevations, the storks then soar effortlessly for many miles, gradually decreasing in height, to new feeding grounds. Long-lived for a bird, wood storks can live up to 20 years.

To keep our stork and many other native species, we must keep our wetlands.

## **Sharing the Garden with Butterflies**

*ur* home gardens can supply a variety of veggies, kitchen herbs and plants for pollinators. Still, it can be quite a surprise to find parsley or dill, intended for soups and stews, eaten down to bare stalks by hungry

caterpillars. If you have space, it may be a good idea to plant a variety of butterfly host plants or enough herbs to share with the caterpillars.

in common. Monarch caterpillars eat milkweed leaves, gulf fritillary caterpillars only eat passion flower leaves and giant swallowtails feed on the leaves of prickly ash, citrus and rue. Black swallowtail caterpillars eat several host plants, including parsley and dill. Planting bronze fennel nearby can be an attractive solution as the female butterflies will often choose this plant over parsley or dill to lay eggs. Several caterpillars can hatch and grow on a single fennel plant, and they can eat a lot of the leaves and stems. Usually bronze fennel eaten down to the stalks in summer comes back to full, lush plants in cooler weather.

Golden alexander (Zizia aurea), found mostly in Central and North Florida, makes a good addition to a pollinator garden. Fragrant clusters of tiny yellow flowers bloom in spring providing an early nectar source for bees and butterflies, and the black swallowtail caterpillars feed on the leaves.

Rue (Ruta graveolens) is an herb that serves as a host plant for both black swallowtails and giant swallowtails. It grows well in our Florida climate and usually is still going strong in late summer when most of the feathery herbs are gone.

A garden with host plants for caterpillars and nectar flowers for adults can provide a place for each stage from tiny eggs to adult butterflies. With luck, if you watch closely, you might see the remarkable life cycle of a beautiful butterfly unfold in the garden.

## **VETERAN'S CORNER**

hope this message finds you and your Family's healthy and safe! I wanted to inform you that in my Zoom meetings with Largo City Hall, they will not allow us to have a Live event this year for

Veteran's Day, once again they will be doing a virtual event. I wanted to wish you all a Happy Veteran's Day!

There is good news from the hill that Congress passed a Continuing Resolution to fund government operations until December 11th. The bad news is, that it is a Continuing Resolution - with limited advance money for new programs, and funding remaining at FY 2020 levels. Divisiveness on the Hill will be in full bloom over the next few months because of the hearings on the Supreme Court nominee. That is bound to have an impact on getting the regular business of Congress -- finalizing the NDAA and completing all the appropriations bills -- done by the December deadline.

Also, there is the matter of the repeated threat of a Presidential veto of the NDAA because of the provisions on changing the names of Military facilities, blocking the transfer of DoD funds for building the "Wall", and halting the cuts to military health facilities and personnel.

One of the big things as Veterans, we want this time is section 1090B in S-4049 (the Senate NDAA) is included in the final NDAA out of the Joint Conference Committee. That specific provision would provide VA coverage of three "presumptive" conditions linked to Agent Orange -- bladder cancer, Parkinson's-like symptoms, and hypothyroidism. A vote was taken on the initial Senate NDAA but the listed Senators voted against it. Scott (FL), Paul, Lee, Kennedy,

Cruz voted NAY on section 1090 B in the (S-4049 the Senate NDAA) which provides coverage to Vietnam Vets for three new presumptive diseases associated with exposure to Agent Orange, as I stated above. These five were the only votes against that Amendment. I am asking you do contact Senator Scotts office to ask him to support the NDAA with section 1090B is included in the final NDAA. They should be voting again in early November after the elections. You can goggle his name and you will come up with his contact info and email him or you can contact him at 202-224-5274 or his mailing address at 716 Hart Senate Office Building, Washington, DC 20510. Although the NDAA is important to all of us in the Military, as I said above it is really important this year for Vietnam Veteran's. It's estimated that 80,000 Vietnam veterans may be suffering these longstanding illnesses from exposure to Agent Orange, and may be helped by this legislation.

Military dependents and retirees now have through the end of June 2021 to access benefits using ID cards that expired this year, thanks to an extension of temporary ID card rules issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Typically, cards must be applied for, issued and updated in person up to 30 days before the expiration date at one of the more than 1,600 ID card offices on military facilities worldwide. Cards that do not expire, such as those held by retirees over 65, do not need to be renewed. But in an effort to reduce crowds at ID card facilities during the pandemic, officials in April issued guidance allowing dependents and retirees to continue to use cards that expired this year to access both military bases and benefits through the end of September. New guidelines issued this month bump that expiration extension into next year. Now, holders of those cards will be able to use them for benefits such as medical care through June 30, 2021, and for base access through March 2021.
