Revisiting the Parking on a Sidewalk Dilemma


Te have all seen people with mobility issues having to leave a sidewalk to walk around a parked car. There have been several articles in our newsletter concerning parking on sidewalks, emphasizing the potential dangers of doing so.

Our Paradise Island Rules and Regulations and Bylaws state:

XI. VEHICLES, TRAFFIC AND TRAILERS

- 1. Speed limit for all vehicles is fifteen (15) miles per hour.
- 2. Residents shall park their vehicles in their driveway or in front of their home. The driveway is to be used for parking cars and not as a storage area. In the event all available parking spaces are occupied residents and guests are allowed to park on the street and shall not block driveways or sidewalks adjacent thereto, provided the guests are not in the Community over thirty (30) days. No parking by residents or their guests on grass areas or over yellow marked storm drains is permitted. Residents/Guests may not park in common areas except to attend functions or to use one of the community amenities. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.
- 3. No resident/guest shall park on any street directly across from another parked vehicle thus restricting, blocking or creating a hazard for the normal flow of traffic for emergency response vehicles i.e. fire equipment or ambulances.
- a. Residents/guests must park on the same side of the street that their home is located facing in the direction of the normal flow of traffic. They must not block or create a hazard for oncoming traffic.
- b. Positively no parking on the West side of St. Martin Way (Clubhouse side) between St. Thomas and Bimini. Cars breaking this rule will be towed at owner's expense.



Looking at the situation from the viewpoint of the law in Florida: FS316.1945 states: "Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device, no person shall: stop, stand, or park a vehicle on the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or park at the edge of the curb of the street; on a sidewalk; within an intersection; or on a crosswalk." The key point here with regard to our dilemma centers on the phrase "Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with law," The law states that a car may not be parked on a street such that the passage of emergency vehicles is obstructed or hindered (FS316.194). The street width for many of the streets within Paradise Island is such that parking entirely on a street would hinder passage of ambulances and fire apparatus. So our dilemma reduces to a "darned if you do, darned if you don't" decision. The best option is to park in our driveways, failing that, common sense tells us that leaving the street clear for emergency vehicles takes precedent over not parking on the sidewalk. Try to leave a little room on the sidewalk for someone to walk pass the car on the lawn side and, never park directly opposite a car on the other side of the street.

Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.






Paradise Island Libraries: Books and DVD's
