Managers Message

Park Royale Residents:
I am so pleased to announce that as states and municipalities begin to lift restrictions related to the COVID-19 crisis, we have been preparing to re-open amenities in our community. Our primary focus throughout this process is the health and well-being of our residents and team members.

To ensure your safety, we have developed a phased approach. We have been working diligently behind the scenes to secure the proper protective equipment, signage, and cleaning supplies, we will move into phase one **on** Monday, May 4th, as detailed below.

Phase One: Restricted Operations

This phase will be focused on opening our outdoor amenities; however, restrictions and/or operational modifications may still apply in some amenities and common areas. You will also notice social distancing signage, sanitizer dispensers and enhanced cleaning protocols throughout the community.

The following amenities will open in our community, Park Royale, Monday, May 4th:

- Community Office Hours will be Monday Friday 8 AM 5 PM for team members; for residents, by appointment only, adhering to 6 ft. social distancing.
- Pool –Open with <u>capacity & seating reduced to 11. Please do not bring your own chairs.</u>
- Tennis/Pickleball Open with no more than 10 people and adhering to 6 foot social distancing.
- Bocce Ball & Horseshoes Open with no more than 10 people and adhering to 6 foot social distancing.
- Driving Net Open with 6 foot social distancing.



- Shuffleboard Court Open with no more than 10 people and adhering to 6 foot social distancing.
- Dog Park Open, please adhere to 6 foot social distancing
- Laundry Open with no more than two people doing laundry at a time & adhering to 6 foot social distancing.

The following amenities will remain closed until all State restrictions are lifted:

- Fitness Center
- Billiard Room/Library
- Clubhouse

Please know the above is subject to change in accordance with State and local guidelines.

Health & Safety Protocols

We take standards for hygiene and cleanliness very seriously and are taking additional steps to ensure the safety of our residents and team members.

- Real-time monitoring of information related to COVID-19.
- Posting signage reminding of CDC guidelines and handwashing procedures
- Defined cycles and procedures for frequent cleaning and disinfection of high-touch areas.
- Distribution of EPA-registered disinfectant products to all locations.







- 2. There has been no real increase in violent crimes in our area.
- 3. There has been a new bus stop at Walmart on 19 and at the Park Mall on Park Blvd. This is being monitored by the police because of the increase of the homeless.
- 4. In addressing the increase in the homeless, there is a current interest in getting the Nuisance Abatement rule reinstated. This would provide the police the ability to encourage these homeless people to move along or go to shelters or Progress Hope. According to Officer Leeks, Progress Hope helps the homeless to prepare for the future.

All in all, Officer Leeks reported our area is in good shape. The next meeting of the Neighborhood Watch will be posted on the board at the Clubhouse.

They have been trained by the VA to help guide people through these types of stresses. You can chat online at no cost whatsoever. VetsPrevail also offers online communities - sort of like message boards or Facebook groups - exclusively for Veterans. VetsPrevail also provides education and skill development activities that you can do by yourself, at home, at your own pace. Research has shown that these skills improve how people cope with stress and challenges, and support well-being.

VetsPrevail is built by vets, run by vets, and serves vets. There is no gimmick, no catch, and no up-sell.

VA's 3-Part Plan to Resume Full Services for Veterans

The first phase, to occur within the next month, will largely consist of assessments by VA facilities to determine the risks and impact of increasing operations, such as non-emergency procedures like clinical visits and lab tests and admissions to spinal cord injury units. Officials will also explore the capacity for community health care providers to resume seeing veteran patients.

In this phase, the Veterans Benefits Administration will increase virtual hearings and formulate plans to resume face-to-face compensation and pension exams, while the National Cemetery Administration will prepare for resuming memorial services and burials that will be held later.

Phase 2 will include expanding non-emergency procedures and medical visits to hospitals and clinics; reopening the department's Fisher Houses; resuming memorial services and burials with military honors, with limited attendance based on local conditions; and in-person services at VBA regional offices, by appointment.

The final phase will build on the others: resuming visitor access to all VA health facilities, including nursing homes, expanding services at VHA and VBA locations, and resuming all other normal operations.



How to make your own hand sanitizer:

ere is what you will need:



- 2 parts isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) with a concentration of 92%
- Essential oil, such as lemon or lavender (this is an optional ingredient for scent).
- Clean containers for mixing and an air-tight container for storage.
- Spoon or whisk for mixing.

Steps

- 1. Combine the aloe vera gel or glycerin with the isopropyl alcohol in a clean container. To get one cup of sanitizer, combine 1/3 cup of gel or glycerin with 2/3 cup of rubbing alcohol.
- 2. Mix thoroughly with your spoon or whisk to ensure that the alcohol is evenly distributed throughout the gel.
- 3. Stir in five drops of essential oil if you are using it. This is entirely optional and is only meant to improve the scent of the sanitizer.
- 4. Store the sanitizer in an air-tight container. Alcohol evaporates with time, so an air-tight container will keep your sanitizer effective for longer. A pump or squeeze bottle can minimize evaporation while keeping your sanitizer container for your sanitizer is clean and airtight.

DECLARATION OF HOMESTEAD AND/OR DOMICILE

The Declaration of Homestead and the **Declaration of Domicile** are two very important documents every owner of a manufactured or mobile home need to know about.

In the State of Florida, a manufactured or mobile home is considered a motor vehicle.

The filing of a **<u>Declaration of Homestead</u>** provides you with legal protection against the forced sale of your home such as bankruptcy or lawsuits. It doesn't protect you from the payment of taxes.

The <u>Declaration of Homestead</u> is filed with the Clerk of the Courts for the county where you live.

The Filing of a <u>Declaration of Domicile</u> provides you with a permanent resident in Florida even though you may have another residence in another state or jurisdiction. A residence designation will provide you with access to location specific social services in addition to fun parks.
