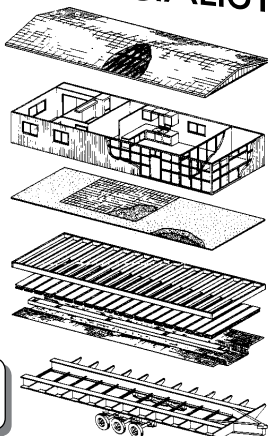

Memorial Day 2019

Memorial Day is a holiday only known to Americans. It is celebrated to remember military service members who have died in the line of duty. On May 5, 1868, General John Logan issued a declaration that ‘Decoration Day’ be centered on decorating the graves of those who had fallen in the Civil War between 1861-1865 and be observed nationwide. Waterloo was the official birthplace of Decoration - Memorial Day, the official date of origin was May 30, 1868 and designated as a day to decorate the graves of “comrades who died in defense of their country.”

In 1882, the name of the holiday was officially changed to Memorial Day. After World War I, the holiday was expanded to remember soldiers from all American Wars. In 1971, Richard Nixon made Memorial Day a national holiday to be celebrated on the last Monday in May.

A few traditional events include:

Laying of the wreath at Arlington Cemetery – Often, the President of the United States will lay a wreath at Arlington Cemetery on the annual observance of Memorial Day and usually accompanied by a speech.

Remembrance and Moments of Silence – People nationwide participate in parades and still partake in decorating graves with wreaths or flowers. Many people will pause for moments of silence in memoriam.

May your holiday be the best ever as you reflect on those who served for our freedom!

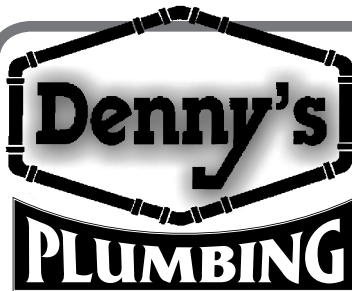

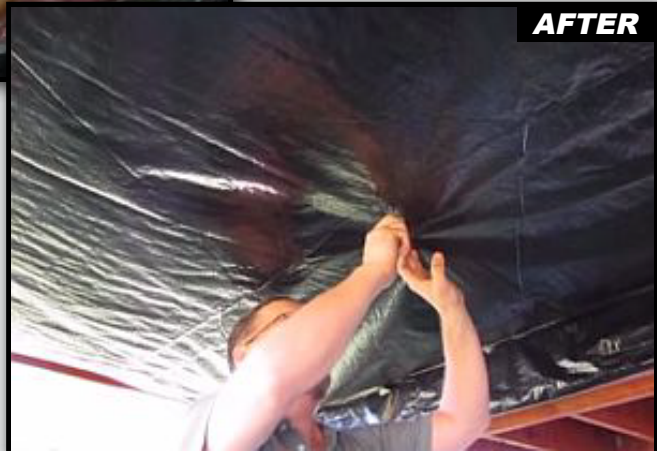

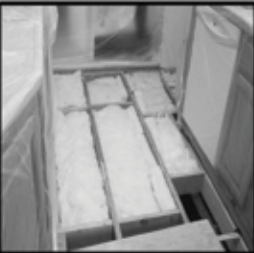

Frosted Lemon Sour Cream Sugar Cookies

Author: Jackie Raffaele

These Lemon Sour Cream Sugar Cookies are soft, moist and loaded with lemon!

Servings: 24 Large cookies

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup butter room temperature
- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 4 large eggs
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- zest of 2 lemons
- juice of 1 lemon
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 4 1/2 cups all-purpose flour

Frosting:

- 1/4 cup butter room temperature
- 2 1/2 cups powdered icing sugar
- juice of 2 lemons*
- yellow food coloring optional

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F and line 4 baking sheets with parchment paper.
2. In a large bowl with an electric mixer, beat butter until smooth. Add sugar and beat until light and fluffy, about 2-3 minutes.
3. Add eggs, sour cream, lemon zest, and lemon juice and beat until combined.
4. Add the baking soda, baking powder and flour and beat just until combined. Dough will be the consistency of thick cake batter -- it is quite sticky and soft.
5. Drop dough by heaping tablespoonfuls onto prepared baking sheets (I get 6 on a regular baking sheet -- cookies are large!), trying to make drops as round as possible. Bake for 10-11 minutes or until no longer glistening in the center. Cool completely.
6. Frosting: With an electric mixer, beat butter until smooth. Add sugar and just enough lemon juice to make a smooth, thick frosting (you can add a teaspoon of milk if it is too thick). Color with yellow food coloring if desired.
7. When cookies are completely cool, spread with an even layer of frosting and serve.

Notes

*I use the juice of 2 lemons and no milk, and the frosting has a strong lemon flavor -- if you prefer less zing, use the juice of 1 lemon and just enough milk to reach desired consistency. ** You can definitely make smaller cookies and the recipe will yield more; you will just want to decrease the baking time.

Fuel from plastic? It could be coming

Recycling to reduce waste and protect the environment isn't a new idea. However, a new process may be able to recycle up to 25 percent of our plastic waste into fuel, according to the Science Alert website. Chemists at Purdue University have been able to liquefy the polymers that make up about a quarter of plastic waste and turn it into diesel-like products that can be used as a blendstock for fuel.



The process, called hydrothermal liquefaction, involves heating water under heavy pressure to work as a solvent and catalyst for transforming the molecular makeup of polymers. With the addition of some hydrogen atoms, this converts the plastic into a fluid called naphtha.

Previous results were disappointing, but the Purdue team of chemical engineers recently converted more than 90 percent of the polypropylene used in an experiment into fuel-grade naphtha. Further analysis suggests that the process could be a more efficient and environmentally friendly way of dealing with plastic waste than burning it or recycling it.

Mysteries of the ancient stone monuments

Stonehenge is probably the most well-known monument built by ancient humans, but it's not alone. As The New York Times reports, there are as many as 35,000 such structures in Europe, ranging from stone circles to dolmens (tablelike structures) and standing stones. Recent radiocarbon dating reveals that the earliest of these stone structures were built in France some 6,500 years ago and their construction spread to England, Ireland, and Scandinavia, as well as along the Atlantic and Mediterranean coasts over 200–300 years.

Many of the dolmens were used as tombs and could be reopened to permit additional burials. The earliest known dolmen was built in central western France between 4371 and 4262 B.C.

Sicily, Apulia and the Balearic Islands saw a wave of megaliths built between 1000 and 2000 B.C. Stonehenge was constructed sometime late in the megalithic heyday, in approximately 2500 B.C.

Breakthroughs arise when someone can combine many ideas together. Think broadly, not deeply.
