Horn of plenty: The myth and the symbol

he cornucopia, or horn of plenty, has long been heralded as a symbol of nature's abundance. Its history is long and rich.

In Greek mythology, it was one of the horns of the goat Amalthaea, who nursed the god Zeus as a baby. The horn was believed to have produced ambrosia and nectar, which were believed then to be the food of the gods.

A Roman myth says that the horn of the cornucopia came from the river god Achelous, who transformed into a bull to fight with the hero Hercules. When Hercules broke the horn from the river god's head, water nymphs filled the horn with flowers and fruit and left it as an offering to Copia, the goddess of plenty.

These stories have contributed to the image of the cornucopia as a symbol of gratitude for a good harvest, making it an appropriate symbol for Thanksgiving Day.
