# Dogs, the Leash of our Worries

s you know, we are required by the Park to Place dogs on leashes when outside of our homes, and you likely know that all dog leashes have the same purpose, to keep your dog safe and under control while out in public. An unleashed pet may present a danger to itself and to others. The issue is not 'whether we should use a leash or not' (we know we should), the issue is 'what kind of leash should we use?' In this article, we will compare the standard dog leash to the popular retractable leash and its use in the park.

The standard dog leash measures from four feet to eight feet in length, but six feet is the most common. Six feet allows plenty of room for freedom of movement, while being short

enough to afford the handler complete control of their dog if necessary.

Longer leashes, including the retractable leash, have been connected to fatal accidents because the owner was unable to control the pets speed and direction. It only takes a second for a dog, quietly walking on the sidewalk, to dart in front of a car. A six foot leash lets the owner control the animal's movement more readily.

All dogs can be trained to walk at a heeled position and to ignore other distractions, but no dog is perfect, especially when a squirrel is involved.

If the owner is not alert enough, his dog's abrupt behavior on a retractable leash could put him smack on the road in front of a speeding car.

It is also impossible, while using a retractable leash to monitor what your pet smells and possibly eats while on a walk. This can be a serious problem if he quietly consumes something not healthy for him. It is equally impossible to predict where our dog may choose to urinate or defecate. This is the real issue in our Park especially where pets are restricted from some areas.

Standard six foot leashes have wrist straps, while retractable issues rarely do. A common problem with retractable leash is dropping. If your dog is stretched out on a retractable leash and you accidently drop the hard plastic handle, it cold hurdle toward your pet and injure him. Thinking he is being pursued by the handle, he may even run away. If you grab the cord or tape while it is being pulled by your pet, you could suffer cuts or burns to your hands. The longer leash also provides a higher risk of getting your dog's leash tangled, sometimes around you.

One common occurrence while using the retractable leash is for the dog to slip out of his collar or "pop" his collar by darting for that pesky squirrel. When this happens the metal clip and collar will fly back to you and could cause serious injury to your face, teeth or eyes.

Which leash you choose is certainly up to each dog owner, but we reserve the use of our retractable leash to settings where free roaming is appropriate. We don't use them in the park and don't recommend it to our dog owning friends.



# Check medical bills with care

ealing with health insurance claims can be frustrating and time-consuming. Multiple bills from different departments for what seems like one medical procedure can baffle even the most organized consumer. The key is to keep track of insurance claims and keep detailed records. Follow this advice:

- **Review records**. Verify that the medical provider has the correct billing information. Also, check the identification or group number of your insurance plan on claim forms.
- Follow up to be sure the claim is being processed. Contact the provider or insurer after receiving a bill to confirm receipt. Write down the names of everyone you speak to, noting the date of the call and any available confirmation numbers.
- **Verify all the expenses.** Check to see if you are being billed twice. Similarly, verify that the contracted rate between the insurer and the provider is actually what you are being billed for.

# Revamp your finances to save more money

If you can figure out how to save just \$125 per month, then set up an automatic savings to a mutual fund that yields an average of 7 percent, in five years you will have almost \$9,000. In 20 years, that amount will have grown to \$65,000! Here are four suggestions for coming up with that \$125 per month:

• Look at your cable TV bill. Do you need all those channels? You can roll your bill back by getting rid of premium channels or subscribing to a smaller, cheaper package.

- Stop picking up magazines from the supermarket or newsstand. Save yourself some money by reading online or subscribing to your favorite magazine instead. And if you're subscribing to anything you don't read, cancel it.
- Change your cell service. Shopping around can get you a better deal that will save you bucks. Just make sure you won't be penalized for breaking a contract early.
- Call your credit card company. You may be able to get a lower interest rate just by asking.


