

If you wish to have it taken out of your automatic withdrawal account, you have to do nothing. If not paid before March 31st, by check, it will be deducted along with the rent, water and sewer by April 5th. Otherwise, if paying by check, please drop it off at the office made out to Park Royale. You may also add it onto the same check you will be paying your rent, water/sewer for April. The total for 2015 Pass on Tax is \$226.34.

### From the H.O. A. Director

hy Join the H.O.A.???

Ask yourself why you moved into a Mobile Home Park. Is it because it is an affordable way to live in a great location in a quiet, caring community. The H.O.A. is your voice to take concerns and problems to the Park Owner's management – and, in the course of a year, there are many of them.

Some residents, to avoid joining, ask the question – What has the H.O.A. done for me? I won't list all the accomplishments now, but ask you to read my article in the January 2016 Media listing many of the things we have achieved in the past three years.

Now let me ask you – WHAT WILL YOU DO WHEN SUN COMMUNITIES SENDS YOU A REGISTERED LETTER TELLING YOU "THE PARK HAS BEEN SOLD AND YOU HAVE 90 DAYS TO PACK UP AND LEAVE"?? Would it not be nice to know that you belonged to a strong H.O.A. with almost 100% participation (not the current 25% membership) to stand up and fight for our rights. I'm not suggesting that this will happen, but it could and has happened to other parks in Florida.

For your information, there are 2350 Registered Mobile Home Parks in Florida with 300,000 lots. All of these Parks fall under the umbrella of an organization called Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc. This is a NOT FOR PROFIT membership organization! It is run strictly by volunteers and has been fighting for our rights since 1962.

The first thing the F.M.O. did was to get the State of Florida to pass the Statute known as Chapter 723 – THE FLORIDA MOBILE HOME ACT. Another major accomplishment was the TIE DOWN PROGRAM initiated with the State contributing \$2.8 million dollars. Many years ago your H.O.A. took advantage of this program and most of the homes we are living in today have proper tie downs. Another recent success was the defeat of the State of Florida trying to impose Sales Tax on the rent we pay. This saves all of us approximately \$500 yearly.

Recently the F.M.O. Board of Directors passed a resolution whereby they will create a fund of \$500,000, so money will be available when problems arise such as Park Owners trying to sell

their Parks leaving the tenants high and dry. To get this money they will be asking individual parks to contribute \$3,000. I would like Park Royale to do their share, however with only 75 paid up members we simply don't have the money.

We need your help ... You need our help ... Together we can go forward with a strong voice to maintain the way of life we are currently enjoying. Please join your H.O.A. for a \$20

membership fee and also consider joining the F.M.O. for an additional \$25.

Come to the next HOA meeting to see what we are all about. We look forward to seeing you there. The cost to join is just \$20.00 per household per year. We, the directors of the HOA and members, support you, why don't you support us!

HOA Membership cards are available at each HOA meeting! Let's go for 100 % Membership!!!
