

<u>NEW HOMES</u> – Just 2 left – 66095 Windsor 2 bed/2 bath with Study was \$ 91,995.00 now \$88,995.00. \$1,000.00 referral fee once they move in. There will be a new home coming in Oct. at 66289 Cambridge. This is a 2/2 with Veranda room for \$91,995.00.

All Hazard Guides are available in the clubhouse – This will help you prepare for hurricanes.

<u>Guests</u> – ALL guests MUST be registered in the guest book in the clubhouse. The guests are not allowed to bring a pet. They are allowed to stay for 3 weeks in the 1st 6 months and 3 weeks in the 2nd 6 months. They can park in designated parking (ie. By clubhouse, and on Regent)

<u>TRASH COMPACTOR</u> – It seems we the trash compactor has been broken or jammed quite frequently. In order to limit this issue we ask that you Please <u>DO NOT</u> leave or put large items beside the compactor or in the compactor. <u>IT WILL JAM!!!</u> (Examples: bikes, bedframes, tires, plywood larger than 2'X 2', curtain rods, furniture of any kind, propane bottles, carpet larger than 3' wide rolls, large branches or big bundles of cut bushes) <u>DO NOT PUSH</u> the RED BUTTON in front – The compactor will stop working.

<u>PETS</u> – There are still some pet owners not looking for the paws in the window. PLEASE I am asking that when you walk your dog/dogs take the time to look for the paw in the window and keep them off the lawns where there are NO Paw stickers in the windows. (I personally see this every day) especially on corner lots and along Windsor.

<u>WATER METERS</u> – So far the water meter issue is tabled. Most votes have been NO. This was the 1st step in getting meters approved. The 2nd step would be to get the company to approve \$195,000.00+ to pay for meters while residents pay it back. The odds of getting this approve is slim.



This is what we know:

- Residents will be billed for 0-3,000 \$ 52.85 gallons whether they are here or not
- We know the cost of the digital meters
- We know you will not be able to put meters in seasonal shut off mode
- We know each home would have their own shut off valve

What we don't know.

- We don't know the exact cost of installation
- We don't know if the company will approve the money to support the install before residents pay.

The Park will probably be 100% full by the end of this year. Therefore I would like to encourage some proactive monitoring for leaks in your homes. Always check under sink, under the home for leaky pipe, toilets that run or spigot that are leaking.

<u>Curb Appeal</u> – SUN communities is big on beautiful lawns and landscaping. Please always follow the City of Pinellas parks water restrictions. I will be giving friendly reminder calls and letters when we see your landscaping may need some attention or your carport is cluttered.

<u>CARPORTS</u> – Residents shall not store items under or around the mobile home, build fences or make changes <u>without written permission from the Park Manager</u>. Extra sheds are not permitted. You will get 2 friendly reminder calls and a written rule reminder then we will charge your ledger.

<u>LOTS</u> – The prospectus states that residents are responsible for maintaining a clean and neat overall appearance of the lot. The lot shall be kept free of litter. Residents may plant additional landscaping shrubs with the approval of the Park Manager. No holes may be dug deeper than one (1) foot. No vegetable growing is allowed.

Lots not maintained to satisfactory standards will be maintained by the Park and costs will be charged to the resident's ledger. 2 friendly reminder calls will be made to correct the issue and a written rule reminder will be delivered to your home. Then we charge your ledger. So please, I am asking you all to take the time to look at your shrubs and flowerbeds to see if they need trimmed or weeded.

<u>Changes to home or lot</u> – if you plan on making any changes (examples: fences, screen rooms, patio blocks, etc) you must see the Park Manager and get approval.

SPRINKLERS – Irrigation and new sod is encouraged. We ask that you follow the water restrictions from the City Of Pinellas Park.

Scientists create negative mass in the laboratory

Tegative mass might sound like something out of science fiction, but physicists have created it in a laboratory. The BBC News website reports that scientists at Washington State University have created a particle composed of negative mass by using lasers to trap atoms of rubidium and then cooling them down to just above absolute zero. This caused the atoms to behave as a superfluid liquid, flowing without losing any energy.

Paradoxically, if you push something with negative mass, it accelerates in your direction, following behavior predicted by quantum mechanics. Scientist expect the technique to help them solve questions about black holes, neutron stars, and dark energy in the cosmos.

Ancient bone raises modern questions

n artifact unearthed in Crimea may shed new light on our Neanderthal ancestors, according to the Sci-News website. It's a bone fragment from a raven, and it's approximately 38,000 years old. A mere 18 mm long, the bone bears a series on notches that are too evenly spaced to be the result of everyday butchery. Archaeologists believe that two notches on the raven bone could have been made intentionally by Neanderthals to create a pattern meant to be consistent or symbolic. The bone may have worn as a personal ornament, some speculate.

Traditional books are alive and well

Publishers and traditional readers alike have long been worried about the rise of electronic books as sales of Amazon's Kindle and other devices have grown, but their concerns may have been at least somewhat overblown. New studies suggest that the growth of e-book sales is leveling out—and possibly declining.

According to the Chicago Tribune website, during the first nine months of 2016 e-book sales dropped by 18.7 percent compared with the same period a year earlier. On the other hand, hardcovers, paperbacks, and audiobooks did not suffer a similar decline. In the same time frame, e-books' share of the total market fell to 17.6 percent from 21.7 percent. In addition, sales of hardcover books in 2016 outpaced e-books for the first time in five years.

Don't panic—books don't look like they're being replaced any time soon.

More Americans taking advantage of technology

he digital revolution continues gaining ground, according to the Pew Research Center. Seventy-seven percent of Americans own a smartphone, a figure that's almost doubled since Pew began tracking smartphone ownership in 2011.

Similarly, broadband access is on an upswing, with home broadband service rising 6 percent in 2016 (after a slight decline from 2013 to 2015). In November 2016, nearly three-quarters (73 percent) of Americans reported having broadband service.

Finally, 69 percent of U.S. adults are using social media, especially young people—86 percent of 18- to 29-year-olds are on at least one social media platform.

New hope for headache sufferers

luster headaches, such as migraines, are rare, but they can cause intense pain to the people (mostly men) who suffer from them.

But there's hope. According to the NBC News website, the Food and Drug Administration has recently approved a device known as the vagus nerve stimulator for treatment of cluster headaches. Sufferers place the small device, named gammaCore, against the neck and send a mild electrical stimulation to the vagus nerve—a large nerve that runs from the brain to the colon. The jolt disrupts signals along the nerve, reducing the pain.

Vagus nerve stimulation is already used to treat ailments such as epilepsy and depression. Gammacore, manufactured by the organization electroCore, is available in Europe, but electroCore plans to begin offering it in the United States later this year.
