





around the Park. She is a regular at most events and participates in most activities such as Bocce, Shuffle and crafts. And away from the Park she is a regular at the German/American Club dances and a few nights a week she is a solo karaoke entertainer. The participation in these activities is similar to many in the Park but Anna surpasses the norm as she is 93 years old, about 20 years senior to most residents. Believe me, she didn't get to this time and place by having a life of luxury, actually far from it!! Anna was born in 1922 in Germany/Austria. She was one of three children who had to quickly thrive to survive. This strength, along with hard work, has probably been her survival mode for her entire life.

Anna began working at the age of 5 digging potatoes along with her mother. By the age of 7 she had advanced to milking cows, sewing, cooking and working in the fields. After the harvest at age 12 she began her flight to Canada. It involved walking barefoot, as the only shoes she had were saved for church, sleeping in a barn and, on one occasion sleeping in a ditch.

By age 13 Anna was making her way to Canada but all travels were curtailed as Anna had developed a goiter. She and her mother tried to find a doctor in Paris who would operate, but none were willing. Anna relied on potatoes and after boiling them, put them in a towel and placed on the goiter. She also used iodized salt and eventually the goiter went away.

The desire to get to Canada resumed and Anna and her mother landed 1000 miles north of Toronto to be with the husband and father. They stayed in his drafty shack on his 280 acres of woods. It was very cold and dark and the wolves could be heard into the night. With little food most of the time, Anna used potatoes as the staple for meals.

A turning point occurred when the War broke out and Anna was living in Hamilton. After a courtship of 4 years, Anna married. She and her husband started a pinball/juke box business. While her husband worked 16 to 18 hours a day, Anna continued long days cleaning the machines and doing housework. After he passed away, Anna stated that she "cut pennies in half" to get to Florida. She also commented that she was so busy in life that she never had time to think about her life, as it was then and is now, her advice was to just stay active.

And that she has done!

When in Florida she found Park Royale. From this point she focused on her handiwork such as smocked dresses, crochet work, cut work and numerous other beautiful pieces of art. The smocked dresses and bonnets are of the finest quality. At any time Anna can tell you how many hundreds of slippers or towels she has made. And she says that she has loved every stitch that she has made. But there is always time for dancing and socializing.

Anna has another record, as she has probably gone on more cruises than anyone else in the Park. Her total now is 29, but will be 30 by the end of this winter. Cruises are not just for relaxing for Anna as she goes to entertain. She is always welcomed to tell a joke or two that are received well.

So behind this feisty senior that we see, there is a wealth of talent, humor, pain and a whole history of life.
