



Elliot Cameron

Eliot was born in Chicago Illinois. He moved away from home in his twenties to Los Angeles, he soon quit his job because he wanted something different, so he became a drummer in a band. He soon became homeless and penniless. He saw a sign the read: "Uncle Sam Wants YOU". He told the recruiting officer that he would join as long as they kept the mess hall open! He enlisted at the age of 26 in February of 1975 and retired in 1995. His rank was MSGT E-8 and his job in the Army was explosives expert. He didn't care about getting all of his hair cut off as long as the mess hall was open. His most memorable moment about boot camp is when he wrote a letter to his Drill Sargent telling him that if he had any problems, he wanted to

discuss with him because he didn't feel the Sargent needed to be yelling at everyone. Needless to say the whole platoon did push up's and grass drills until they were completely exhausted.

Elliot was stationed in Ft. Jackson SC, Huntsville, AL (for explosives training), Germany twice, Italy once, Korea twice, and Saudi Arabia during the gulf war. His favorite posts were Huntsville and Germany. He never saw combat. His worst memory was writing the Drill Sargent in boot camp. His best memory was when he made SGT First Class. He achieved the Good Conduct medal, Many Achievement medal, the Impact Award and the Gulf War medal. He is an avid member of the DAV.

What began as the lighting of candles in the trenches grew to French, German and British soldiers seeking each other out in No Man's Land for the exchanging of gifts, souvenirs, stories and the occasional reference to football (soccer). This tradition was adopted back at home to celebrate those military deployed and in memory of the fallen and continues to this day. The lighting of candles on Christmas Eve is also a ritual employed by most of the religions to mark the birth of the Chosen One or as a prayer for world peace.

The candles and plastic containers are stored each year thanks to the kindness of Sgt-Major Lillian Papelian. The Park's display was thanks to the efforts of the




